Students in grades 9-12 are invited to participate in our high school work-study experience. The program consists of two fundamental building blocks: the **Madrachim Program** and the **Lunch Study Sessions**.

### Madrachim Program

**Sundays 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.:** Those who choose to serve as **Madrachim** (aides in the Academy) will work under the guidance of our Youth Director and our Director of Education while serving as role models for younger students. **Madrachim** can apply for a broad range of concrete assignments and will receive a salary for their work. Assignment choices can be found on page 3 of this form. Training and supervision will be incorporated into the morning work schedule. (Interested and qualified students can also choose to serve as Shabbat Service **Madrachim** on Saturday mornings from 10 - 12, helping out in Tot Shabbat or Jr. Congregation.)

### Lunch Study Sessions

**Sundays, 12:00 p.m. - 1:30 p.m., 4 times per year:** Students will enjoy a complimentary pizza lunch, followed by a high-level lesson and conversation with acclaimed clergy and academics in areas of Jewish interest, with topics ranging from philosophy to negotiating college in the 21st century as a Jewish young adult. These study sessions are considered part of the program and are required for all madrikhim. High school students who are not in the madrikh program are welcome to attend these sessions independently.

### New York Trip

**One weekend in May, all interested HS students go on a dynamic learning excursion to New York** to explore the amazing Jewish history and culture of the city.

### Commencement

**Our high school juniors conclude their 3rd year with a special commencement ceremony,** celebrating their accomplishment and honoring their learning, participation, and dedication. Students who participate only through the end of sophomore year can participate in this ceremony as well, so long as they attend the lunch learning sessions their junior year.
