Students in grades 9-12 are invited to participate in a multifaceted series of programs for both continuing their Jewish education and mentoring our younger students. The following options can be done individually or in combination.

Madrichim Program

Sundays 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.: Those who choose to serve as madrichim will work under the guidance of our Director of Education while serving as role models for younger students. Madrichim can apply for a broad range of concrete assignments and will receive a salary or CS hours for their work. Interested students can also choose to serve as Shabbat service madrichim on Saturday mornings from 10 - 12, helping out in Tot Shabbat or Jr. Congregation.

Community High School

Tuesdays, 6:30 - 8:00 p.m.: Beth Hillel Bnai Emunah is partnering with Moriah Congregation and North Suburban Synagogue Beth El to inaugurate a community Jewish high school for our area. For this first year, the program will meet for one semester at Moriah in Deerfield, and the second semester at Beth El in Highland Park, for dinner and engaging lessons with the clergy of those congregations. Starting the following year, BHBE will serve as a third location. (There is a \$500 charge for this wonderful opportunity.) See attached flyer for information and registration.
