A Five-Year Plan:

Areas of Distribution:

1. School of Jewish Life & Learning programs
2. Participation in organized summer programs in Israel
3. Attending URJ summer camps (not including Sisol and Seneca Lake)
4. Adult Education Programs
5. Saving for future use

School of Jewish Life & Learning programs:

1. No increase in tuition for five years
2. Tuition Cap: Pay tuition for two children; third (lower tuition) attends tuition-free
3. 10th Grade Confirmation Trip: Family pays 1/3 of cost (about \$200)

Participation in organized summer programs in Israel (i.e., JFI, CSL in Israel, NIFTY in Israel, Camp Eisner in Israel, etc.):

1. A one-time \$1,000 total subsidy will be provided to any teen of Temple Sinai member/s.
2. Any teen of Temple Sinai member/s who attends at least **70%** of Keshet classes will receive \$1,000 per year toward his/her Israel *Keshet* Saving Plan, for a possible total of \$3000. This plan will begin in 2016-17 school year.
3. The accumulated amount of \$1000 - \$3,000 may be used up through 12th Grade and till admittance to college. Un-used amount will be forfeited and returned to the fund.
4. Organized Summer Programs in Israel: Q & A (please see attached document)

Attending URJ Summer Camps:

1. A one-time \$1,000 total subsidy will be provided to any teen of Temple Sinai member/s for attending any of the URJ Summer Camps.
2. Because the Farash Foundation provides up to \$1,800 to the families of First Campers, this subsidy will be provided **from the second year of attendance.**

Adult Education Programs:

A five-year contribution plan of a total of \$30,000 will be provided to our Adult Education Programs.

Saving for future use:

About \$22,245 (12%) will be kept in a saving account (or endowed fund) for future use; and/or as a subsidy for excess (more than anticipated) number of participants in any of the first three areas of distribution.
