FAQS/POLICIES/PROCEDURES

SPACE CAPACITIES

*Depending on set-up needs

Herman Hall: 100' x 72' (Roughly 280-350 guests)

Wasserman Atrium: 64' x 65' (Roughly 150 guests)

Korman Hall: 59' x 59' (Roughly 150 guests)

Korman Atrium: 25' x 59' (100 guests)

Pitt Atrium: 37" x 36' (70-75 guests)

DANCE FLOORS

Herman Hall: 21' x 21', 24' x 24', 24'x27' adjustable in 3' increments; up to 30' x 30'

Korman Hall: 18' x 18', 24' x 24', 21'x27' adjustable in 3' increments; up to 21' x 21'

CANCELLATIONS OR TRANSFERS

All cancellations or requests to change the date of an event must be submitted in writing. In the event of a cancellation within 24 months prior to your event, your deposits will be forfeited. Date change requests shall be considered based on availability, within same fiscal year.

EVENT SET-UP & BREAK DOWN

Events set-up may begin—

Saturday: 8:00 am with quiet hour between 10:00am -12:00pm out of respect for religious services taking place. Atrium set up cannot begin until 1:00pm.

Sunday: 1:00pm based on if religious services are taking place.

Temple Israel staff is not able to assist with arranging of place cards, favors, tasting flutes, cake knives, server menus, guestbooks, or pen-card boxes. These items must be placed within 24 hours prior to the event and labeled.

Following the conclusion of the event, renter will ensure all items shall be removed from the premises within the hour. All décor, not belonging to Temple Israel, including but not limited to owers, must be removed at the end of the event or there will be a minimum \$250 clean-up and disposal fee. Temple Israel shall not hold any items after the conclusion of the event without prior consent. Temple Israel is not responsible for any items left behind.

TABLES & CHAIRS

Temple Israel provides all guest, cocktail, place card, challah, gift, and cake tables. Sizes are limited. We also provide mahogany folding chairs as part of our package.

FLOOR PLANS, TABLESCAPE, LINENS

An approved and final floor plan will be due fourteen (14) business days prior to the event.

Temple Israel will not place or remove any rental linens or napkins on any tables. Temple Israel is not responsible for missing or damaged linens or napkins.

EVENT ITINERARY

A tentative timeline is due fourteen (14) business days before the event

PHOTO POLICY

Member agrees to allow Temple Israel to take photos of their event for the purposes of marketing and social media.

VENDORS

Vendors must be approved by Temple Israel. Temple Israel is not responsible for the installation or removal of items provided by an outside vendor. Violation of this policy may result in additional charges against your security deposit.

ADDITIONAL POLICIES

- Temple Israel is a smoke-free facility and smoking is not allowed in the facility or surrounding premises.
- No Pork Products of any kind are allowed.
- Throwing and/or using confetti, rice, birdseed, glitter, etc. is not permitted in the facility or surrounding premises.
- All candles must be encased in glass.
- Taping of items from the walls or ceiling is not permitted.
- Hanging of photos or signs to be hung by Temple approved vendors within the ceiling track only or client provided pipe & drape.
- All power cords must be taped / secured to floor with vendor provided Gaffer Tape.
- Outside baked good and desserts must be prepared by a licensed bakery.
- Day-of Coordinators not provided but can be recommended.
- No gum or cotton candy.
