## **TEMPLE ISRAEL READING STARS FOR 1<sup>ST</sup> GRADE FAMILIES**

All 1<sup>st</sup> Grade families are encouraged to be a **READING STAR** by reading **6** Jewish books during the school year and completing **6 READING STAR** forms. Here is what you need to do to be a **STAR** and win a prize:

1. Read a Jewish book from your home library or from the Hodari Family Children's Library. Your child can check out books from the Library with his/her class, or with a parent before or after Religious School. Children should read the book with an adult (parent, grandparent, or other book lover).
2. Complete the **READING STAR** form and return it to your Religious School teacher. More forms are available from your classroom teacher, in the Media Center or can be printed from the Temple Israel website.
3. Make sure your teacher records your book on the classroom chart.
4. Read **6** Jewish books and complete **6 READING STAR** forms by **April 19, 2020** and receive a prize. Bonus prizes will also be awarded to students who read more than 6 books.
5. Each 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Class that has 100% participation will receive a special class prize as will the class that reads the most books. So, encourage all your classmates to read Jewish books too!
