## WELCOME TO THE 2<sup>nd</sup> GRADE *SIFRIYA* SOCIETY!

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade *Sifriya* (Library) Society is a reading club to encourage students to read Jewish books throughout the school year. Here's what you need to do to win a prize:

1. Read a Jewish book from your home library or from the Hodari Family Children's Library. You can check out books from the Library with your class, or with your parents before or after Religious School. Read the book by yourself or have an adult read it to you.
2. Complete a **Sefer (Book) Report** and return it to your Religious School teacher. More forms are available from your classroom teacher, in the Media Center or can be printed from the Temple Israel website.
3. Make sure your teacher records your book on the classroom chart. Also, students who write exceptional reports will be featured in the Temple Israel Messenger!
4. Read **6** Jewish books and complete **6 Sefer (Book) Report** by **April 19, 2020** to receive a prize. Bonus prizes will also be awarded to students who read more than 6 books.
5. Each 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Class that reaches 100% participation will receive a special class prize as will the class that reads the most books. So, encourage all your classmates to read Jewish books too!
