POP-UP SHABBAT

"God has given us a great gift," I tell all my wedding couples. If it were not for this gift, the human species would not have survived. It is the gift of taking things for granted. Without this gift, we would have stood paralyzed with awe before every flowering plant and never would have gotten to work, never been able to tear ourselves away from the splendor in order to tend to the mundane tasks necessary to our subsistence. Unfortunately, this amazing gift of taking things for granted has never failed to become a problem at some point in any relationship.

Thankfully, however, the rabbis have provided us with a perfect antidote for this problem; it is called Shabbat. Each Friday evening, we are commanded to light romantic candles, share some sweet wine together and be reminded that our relationship is sacred, our lives together, holy. Essentially, it is a date! No matter how difficult the week, how factious our disagreements, we have this guaranteed love time to remind us not to take the people we cherish for granted. And then when children come along, we swoop them up into our arms and they too can share in the blessing of this sacred family time spent together.

This November and December, Temple Israel is embarking on a great experiment to enhance the home-based brilliance of this concept. It is called "Pop-up Shabbat" and we hope that you will avail yourself of its profound potential. For two months we have moved our Kabbalat Shabbat service time to 5:30 pm to allow you to return home and spend the evening with those you love lingering around the Shabbat dinner table, or perhaps on Zoom or FaceTime. We have furthermore partnered with local restaurants to provide sumptuous dinners that you can take home with you from temple to create a beautifully prepared meal for you and your family and/or friends.

Thus, Pop-Up Shabbat is also a way for you to support local restaurants financially, as they certainly will need our help during this long Covid winter once outdoor dining becomes difficult to provide.

Included in every meal will be a free Dakota Bread challah that Temple Israel is contributing to your feast. Dakota Bread, as you may know, is now an affiliate of the Farber Soul Center and we are proud to be supporting them as well through this sacred endeavor.

An ancillary benefit of this program is that the Friday, December 24th Pop-up dinner will most certainly be Chinese. After all, what else would Jews eat on Christmas Eve? And the 5:30 pm start time on Friday, December 31, will allow you to conclude the year with prayer and then go on to celebrate the dawn of 2022 with those you love.

So, please do pop in to our Pop-up Shabbat! Hopefully, these special Sabbath celebrations will help to transform God's gift of taking things for granted into the even greater gift of joyful and delicious moments of appreciation spent together with family and friends.
