I DO IT FOR THE KAVOD:

A RESPONSE TO THE CHIEF RABBINATE OF ISRAEL'S BLACKENING OF MY NAME

A stranger moved into a new town and visited the local shul for Shabbos services. He turned to the man in the pew next to him and inquired about the rabbi.

"Oh, our rabbi is a disgrace," opined the gentleman—a cross between a *schlemiel* and a *schlamazal*," Somehow he manages to be both a *mamzer* and a *nebish* at the very same time. And besides, everyone hates his sermons!"

At the oneg Shabbat, the visitor came upon the Sisterhood president who had delivered the congregational announcements. The conversation turned once again to the rabbi. "Oy," sighed the woman, "if we keep that *schmendrik* as our rabbi for much longer, the Sisterhood will be out of business. And besides, everyone hates his sermons!"

Undeterred, the potential congregant called the synagogue office on Monday. Once connected, he asked the secretary for an appointment with the rabbi. "The rabbi?" She asked surprised. "I hope it is not for counseling. Confidentially, I have to tell you that our rabbi could not counsel his way out of a paper bag. And besides, everyone hates his sermons!"

Nevertheless, the appointment was made and when the stranger sat down in the rabbi's study he said, "Rabbi, it would seem that your position here is quite...how shall I say....stressful."

"Oh yes," the rabbi responded. "I work 16 hours a day, including spending the entire Shabbos here at shul. I devote myself completely to my congregants and therefore I have no family life, no time for hobbies or outside activities, and as a result my wife is threatening to leave me."

"So why do you do it?" responded the man, taken aback.

"Oh that's easy," responded the rabbi with a smile, "I do it for the kavod!" (honor and prestige)

Today, having learned that I have earned the "kavod" of being included on the short list of Orthodox, Conservative and Reform rabbis blacklisted by the so-called "Chief Rabbinate" of Israel, I am that rabbi. Why do I schlep hundreds of people to Israel on temple and Federation missions? I do it for the kavod. Why do I rail against BDS and all anti-Israel movements from the bima? I do it for the kavod. Why do I ardently support AIPAC, JNF, Friends of IDF and so many other pro-Israel organizations? I do it for the kavod. And why have I spent the last three decades of my life serving a congregation built upon the unshakable foundation of Zionism? Clearly, I do it for the kavod.

I am not being entirely facetious here. Since the list appeared, I have received countless emails, Facebook messages and calls from colleagues telling me how jealous they are that they were not included on the list. All I could say to them was, "try harder....maybe next time?" And I am in such good company! The list includes some of the great luminaries of our time, including Detroit's own Rabbi Irwin Groner z"I, who seems to have made the list even though he has been deceased for quite some time now. So yes, I am taking my inclusion on this absurd, surreal, McCarthyisitic "list" as a badge of honor. I am having fun with my fifteen minutes of infamy and I am sure at least one good sermon will come out of it.

I am, however, also very sad—not for myself, but for the State of Israel. Israel has so many enemies, so many detractors, so many who seek her destruction, and their "official" rabbinic leaders are choosing to paint so many illustrious "ohavei Yisrael," so many lovers of Israel, as enemies? It is self-destructive, immoral and so very lacking in even the most basic understanding of the central Jewish concept of clal Yisrael, the unity of the Jewish people. I could spend the rest of this article ranting and raving about the Israeli government's lily-livered reversals in the area of the Western Wall and conversion. I could invoke the specter of "sinat chinam," the "baseless hatred" amongst Jews that is said to have led to the destruction of the Holy Temple in Jerusalem. Instead, however, the Hebrew word that keeps coming to my mind is "mechoar"—this is so very, sadly, disappointingly, tragically ugly.

So no, "chief rabbinate" of Israel, your cowardly blackening of my name will not stop me from bringing busloads of loyal congregants to our Jewish homeland; it will not deter me from fighting with all of my heart for Israel's future; it will not diminish my love of *Eretz Yisrael* in the slightest. Why?

Because clearly.....I do it for the kavod!

HIGH HOLY DAYS

GET INVOLVED

High Holy Days will be here before you know it! We invite you to participate in our services this year. Opportunities include:

Chanting or Reading from the Torah: You must be able to read Hebrew and be willing to work throughout the summer in preparation for services. You will receive a recording of your portion and will work with Carolyn lwrey, our Service Coordinator, to assist you. You do not need to have a professional voice, just a desire to learn how to chant.

Chanting Torah and Haftarah Blessings: The Torah Blessings are the same as the blessings you hear on Shabbat. The Haftarah Blessings, although similar to the Shabbat Blessings, are slightly different. You will receive a recording with the Blessings and will work with our Service Coordinator.

Hebrew Reading: This reading is very short and does not involve chanting. You will receive a CD with the reading and should be able to learn this on your own. However, Carolyn Iwrey will be available to assist you.

English Reading: This reading will either be the English version of the Haftarah or an English prayer. You will receive a hard copy of your portion via the mail two or more weeks prior to the High Holiday.

Torah Carrier: You will be given the honor of carrying the Torah during High Holiday Services. There is no speaking involved.

We hope you will consider joining us in our outreach to include new faces on the Bimah, whether you have been a member of Temple for one year or many years. IT'S TIME TO START THINKING ABOUT THE HIGH HOLY DAYS

Which Service Is Right For Your Family?

<u>Adult Services</u> are for adults and young adults who have attained Bar/Bat Mitzvah age.

<u>Family Services</u> are recommended for children who are 8 years old and above (or reading age) along with their parents and grandparents who are Temple Israel members. There will be a "Family Friendly" service for members eight and older on Kol Nidre. The service will be 7:15 - 8 pm in Korman Hall. This will be the ONLY Family Service on Kol Nidre.

<u>Children's Services</u> are geared to non-readers and their families and are recommended for children 8 years and under, along with parents and grandparents.

Yizkor (Memorial) and Neilah (Concluding) Services

Our integrated Yizkor/Neilah Service will begin at 5:15 pm and conclude at 6:15 pm. Please do not bring a prayer book as one will be provided. An important aspect of the Yizkor service will be our Memorial Booklet. The names of those who have passed away on or since last Yom Kippur will be listed. Please note that these names will not be read aloud. It is important that we have the correct names. If you have a loved one whose name should be listed in this Memorial Booklet we urge you to contact Donna Bolda-Moss at 248-661-5700 or in advance of Rosh Hashanah to confirm the spelling of the name.

HIGH HOLY DAY TICKETS

How do I request my High Holy Day Tickets? By now you should have received your High Holy Day ticket request information. Online registration is now available on our website at Temple-Israel.org/hhd2017member. Services are processed on a first come first served basis. A ticket request must be received to process your High Holy Days service selection.

High Holy Day Guest Passes

Guest passes for visiting <u>out-of-town</u> family only will be available on request if seats are available. ALL families who wish to bring out-of-town guests to a High Holy Day service MUST complete and submit a Guest Request Form. Forms are mailed with your High Holy Days ticket information or feel free to complete the form online at Temple-Israel.org/hhd2017guest. Guest pass selections will be distributed on a first requested basis.

Requests for guest passes may necessitate your entire family being changed to a more available service.

Tickets will only be mailed to those requesting them. Requests must be completed by each family. Tickets will be mailed in the beginning of September.

When will my High Holy Days tickets arrive? Watch your mailbox near the beginning of September for your tickets.




How do I attend the Yom Kippur Study Sessions? Complete the Study Session Form that will arrive with your High Holy Days tickets.

We will make every effort to secure reciprocity for Temple Israel members. To get a list of reform congregations in the appropriate location visit congregations.urj.org. Coordinating reciprocity is never easy at the last moment, so please contact us as soon as possible if you need courtesy seating.

Family Admittance Cards: Please come to Temple Israel together as a family on the High Holy Days and display your family admittance cards to our ushers as you enter. At age 26, young people need to sign up for their own, independent membership and tickets. HIGH HOLY DAYS (CONTINUED)



Inspired by the popular *Moth Radio Hour* (we call it the *Roth Radio Hour*), *Ted Talks* (we call it *Yed Talks*) and the *Chicago Ideas Week* (we call it "*Why Don't You Move Back Home to Michigan Already?*"), MINCHA MOMENTS will once again be a Yom Kippur Afternoon Prayer Service like no other. Personal vignettes will punctuate a Yom Kippur afternoon prayer service that is poetically and musically inspiring.

As in years past, those who attend this afternoon service will have priority in terms of seating for the Yizkor/Neliah service. For those who wish to remain at temple all day, it coordinates beautifully with our Yom Kippur morning services and study sessions. If you do stay all day, please park in the spaces designated for all-day worshipers.

Tickets are required. For more information please call the High Holy Days desk at Temple Israel, 248-661-5700.

All day on Yom Kippur, including special afternoon "Mincha Moments" Service: Spiritually moving and intellectually stimulating study sessions will lead directly into our beautiful Yom Kippur Afternoon Service.

Afternoon Mincha Moments services begin at 3:30 pm.

Separate Cars: We hope that your family will all arrive at Temple in one car. Parking is difficult for all synagogues during the High Holy Days. However, if you must drive separately we suggest that you simply arrange to meet at the doors and walk in together.

Tallit: We encourage you to wear your tallit at the Kol Nidre evening service and at any morning service.

Prayer Books: Each member of your family should have a copy of *The Gates of Repentance*, which can be purchased at Temple during weekday office hours. On Wednesday, September 20 and Friday, September 29 the office will close at noon. The office will also be closed on the High Holy Days.

Handicapped Stickers: Please display any handicapped stickers so our parking lot attendants can see them clearly.

Live Streaming Services: If you cannot be here in person for High Holy Days services, we will bring the services to you! We offer Live Streaming on our website, see page 3 for details.

Alternating Sermons: When you come to our services on Erev Rosh Hashanah, you will take a seat in either the Sanctuary or Herman Hall. The next day, on Rosh Hashanah, those who were in the Sanctuary will worship in Herman Hall, and vice versa. This will allow you to worship with all our clergy and to hear each of the sermons. Anyone who goes to the same room in the evening and during the day will hear the same sermon twice. The same is true for Yom Kippur.

Denial - Based on the acclaimed book **Denial**: **Holocaust History on Trial**, this film recounts Deborah E. Lipstadt's legal battle for historical truth against David Irving, who accused her of libel when she declared him a Holocaust denier.


Wedding Doll - Hagit, a mentally challenged young woman who lives with her mother, finds escape in designing bridal gowns and dolls, using leftover materials from the toilet paper factory where she works. All too aware of life's disappointments, Hagit's mother worries that her daughter cannot separate fantasy from real life. These aching emotional dynamics culminate as the factory's closure threatens Hagit's dreams of marrying the boss' handsome son.

Norman Lear: Just Another Version of You - Tackling hot-button social issues through deft comedy and unusual characters, Lear's 1970s primetime hits prompted household debates on race, class and gender equality. Lear's own colorful story, from his poor Jewish upbringing and WWII army service to his rise through show business ranks, unfolds through personal archives and adored TV moments. Now 93 years old, Lear remains as sharp as ever as he watches and reacts to clips in the film.

SEED: The Untold Story - Passionately follows seed keepers protecting the 12,000-year-old food legacy. In the last century, 94% of seed varieties have disappeared. And today a battle rages between the chemical companies that control the majority of seeds and the farmers, scientists, lawyers and indigenous seed keepers determined to defend the future of food.

Life, Animated - Owen Suskind, son of Pulitzer Prize-winning writer Ron Suskind, was 3 years old when he was diagnosed with autism. As Owen withdrew into silence, his parents almost lost hope that their son would ever interact with anyone. And then something extraordinary occurred: through animated films, especially those of the Walt Disney Company, Owen found a way to understand the world, and his determined family found a way to connect with him.






