A SUMMER OF (JEWISH) CAMP

I recently was mindlessly scrolling through Facebook, when one post jumped out at me, causing me to stop and take a closer look. "Five reasons great parents send their kids to camp!" Now, I know that there are many great parents that choose not to send their children to camp, but I was curious, as a camp person, what these five reasons were. The poster detailed her five reasons: "To gain independence and resilience strategies; to unplug; to have outdoor fun and adventures; to relax (us and them); and to learn to make, navigate and keep friends." These are great reasons, and certainly all skills I learned in my years as a camper.

At Temple Israel, we also strongly value camping experiences, particularly Jewish camping. For that reason, in between leading beautiful outdoor services, running dynamic family programs, officiating at lifecycles, meeting with congregants, and planning for the coming school year, your Temple Israel clergy is spending a combined twelve weeks at Jewish summer camps and on the Teen Mission to Israel. In fact, as you are reading this article, I am packing up my almost two year old to take her with me as I spend a week on faculty at URJ Camp George with fifty of our Temple Israel kids. Why are we dedicating so much of our summer to being at camp? Here are five great reasons:

1. To help our Temple Israel campers further develop their Jewish identity and be a part of their informal Jewish learning experiences.
2. To connect with our kids in their happiest, special places.
3. To reinvigorate our Jewish practices--learning new music, worship skills, stories, and bringing back innovative educational ideas.
4. To share in those fun outdoor adventures—making s'mores, playing sports, going canoeing and hiking—while showing campers what makes each of those experiences Jewish.
5. Because both research and our own experiences have shown us that spending time at a Jewish summer camp is one of the single most influential factors on a child's future Jewish identity and involvement in the Jewish community.

Sure, your clergy love spending time at our beautiful camps but we, at Temple Israel, have long been supporters of Jewish camping because we know that at camp kids are taught about Jewish communal life and then immediately experience it—in their cabins, at meals, on the ropes course, and on the lake. It is a 24/7 immersive Jewish community that exposes campers to adult Jewish role models, and Jewish friends from different places.

So even though we still, thankfully, have a few weeks left of summer, it is not too early to start thinking about what next summer may bring. Talk to us about Jewish summer camping, and which camp may be the best fit for your child. We want to help make this incredible camp experience possible for all our families, so ask us about camp scholarship availability. In the meantime, I'll see you when I am back from Camp George!

IT'S TIME TO START THINKING ABOUT THE HIGH HOLY DAYS

WHICH SERVICE IS RIGHT FOR YOUR FAMILY?

Adult Services are for adults and young adults who have attained Bar/Bat Mitzvah age.

Family Services are recommended for children who are 8 years old and above (or reading age) along with their parents and grandparents who are Temple Israel members. There will be a "Family Friendly" service for members eight and older on Kol Nidre. The service will be 7:15 - 8 pm in Korman Hall. This will be the ONLY Family Service on Kol Nidre.

Children's Services are geared to non-readers and their families and are recommended for children 8 years and under, along with parents and grandparents.

YIZKOR (MEMORIAL) AND NEILAH (CONCLUDING) SERVICES

Our integrated Yizkor/Neilah Service will begin at 5:15 pm and conclude at 6:30 pm. Please do not bring a prayer book as one will be provided. An important aspect of the Yizkor Service will be our Memorial Booklet. The names of those who have passed away on or since last Yom Kippur will be listed. Please note that these names will not be read aloud. It is important that we have the correct names. If you have a loved one whose name should be listed in this Memorial Booklet we urge you to contact the Temple office at 248-661-5700 or in advance of Rosh Hashanah to confirm the spelling of the name.

HIGH HOLY DAY GUEST PASSES

Guest passes for visiting out-of-town family only will be available on request if seats are available. ALL families who wish to bring out-of-town guests to a High Holy Day service MUST complete and submit a Guest Request Form. Forms were mailed with your High Holy Days ticket information. Guest pass selections will be distributed on a first requested basis. Requests for guest passes may necessitate your entire family being changed to an available service. **Please note, all out of town guests will be included on your family admittance card.**

Tickets will only be mailed to those requesting them. Requests must be completed by each family. Tickets will be mailed near the end of August.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW DO I REQUEST TICKETS? WHEN WILL I GET MY FORMS?

By now you should have received your High Holy Day Ticket request information. Online registration is now available at temple-israel.org/hhd. Services are processed on a first come, first served basis. A ticket request must be received to process your High Holy Days service selection.

WHEN WILL MY HIGH HOLY DAYS TICKETS ARRIVE?

Watch your mailbox near the end of August for your tickets.

HOW DO WE REGISTER FOR BABYSITTING DURING THE HIGH HOLY DAYS SERVICES?

A sitter service for children one year of age and older will be available at all High Holy Day services, except Children's Services, BY ADVANCE REGISTRATION ONLY. Complete the Babysitting Request Form online after you receive your High Holy Days tickets.

HOW DO I ATTEND THE YOM KIPPUR STUDY SESSIONS?

Complete the Study Session Form that will arrive with your High Holy Days tickets.

HOW IS OUT OF TOWN SEATING REQUESTED?

If you will be out of town for the holidays and would like us to arrange for courtesy seating at another reform temple, please complete the RECIPROCITY REQUEST FORM online at temple-israel.org/hhd. We will make every effort to secure reciprocity for Temple Israel members. For a list of reform congregations in your desired location, visit congregations.urj.org. Reciprocity is never easy at the last moment, so please complete the online form as early as possible.

ALL DAY ON YOM KIPPUR, INCLUDING SPECIAL AFTERNOON "MINCHA MOMENTS" SERVICE

HIGH HOLY DAYS (CONTINUED)



3:30 pm • Yom Kippur day
September 19

Inspired by the popular *Moth Radio Hour* (we call it the *Roth Radio Hour*), *Ted Talks* (we call it *Yed Talks*) and the *Chicago Ideas Week* (we call it “*Why Don’t You Move Back Home to Michigan Already?*”), MINCHA MOMENTS will once again be a Yom Kippur Afternoon Prayer Service like no other. Personal vignettes will punctuate a Yom Kippur afternoon prayer service that is poetically and musically inspiring.

As in years past, those who attend this afternoon service will have priority in terms of seating for the Yizkor/Neliah Service. For those who wish to remain at temple all day, it coordinates beautifully with our Yom Kippur morning services and study sessions. If you do stay all day, please park in the spaces designated for all-day worshipers.

ALTERNATING SERMONS

When you come to our services on Kol Nidre, you will take a seat in either the Sanctuary or Herman Hall. The next day, those who were in the Sanctuary will worship in Herman Hall, and vice versa. This will allow you to worship with all our clergy and to hear each of the sermons.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

FAMILY ADMITTANCE CARDS: Please come to Temple Israel together as a family on the High Holy Days and display your family admittance cards to our ushers as you enter. At age 26, young people need to sign up for their own, independent membership and tickets. Please call Temple for details on our special, young adult membership plan or visit our Temple Israel website for details. Please note, all out of town guests will be included on your family admittance card.

SEPARATE CARS: We hope that your family will all arrive at Temple in one car. Parking is difficult for all synagogues during the High Holy Days. However, if you must drive separately we suggest that you simply arrange to meet at the doors and walk in together. Please keep in mind that Out of Town Guest Passes will be included on your Member High Holy Day Ticket.

TALLIT: We encourage you to wear your tallit at the Kol Nidre evening service and at any morning service.

HANDICAPPED STICKERS: Please display any handicapped stickers so our parking lot attendants can see them clearly.

LIVE STREAMING SERVICES: If you cannot be here in person for High Holy Days services, we will bring the services to you! We offer Live Streaming on our website, see page 3 for details.

GET INVOLVED

CHANTING OR READING FROM THE TORAH:

You must be able to read Hebrew and able to work throughout the summer in preparation for services. You will receive a recording of your portion and will work with Carolyn Iwrey, our Service Coordinator.

CHANTING TORAH AND HAFTARAH BLESSINGS:

The Torah Blessings are the same as the blessings you hear on Shabbat. The Haftarah Blessings, although similar to the Shabbat Blessings, are slightly different.

HEBREW READING: This reading is very short and does not involve chanting. You will receive a recording with the reading and should be able to learn this on your own.

ENGLISH READING: This reading will either be the English version of the Haftarah or an English prayer. You will receive a hard copy of your portion two or more weeks prior.

TORAH CARRIER: You will be given the honor of carrying the Torah during High Holiday Services. There is no speaking involved.

If you missed these films at the Lenore Marwil Jewish Film Festival in the spring, check them out from the Temple Israel Libraries:

- ▶ **Bombshell: The Hedy Lamarr Story** - Hollywood star Hedy Lamarr was known as the world's most beautiful woman, Snow White and Cat Woman were both based on her iconic look. However, her arresting looks and glamorous life stood in the way of her being given the credit she deserved as an ingenious inventor whose pioneering work helped revolutionize modern communication. Combining this newly discovered interview with intimate reflections from her children, closest friends, family and admirers, including Mel Brooks and Robert Osborne.
- ▶ **Blazing Saddles** - In order to ruin a western town, a corrupt politician appoints a black Sheriff, who promptly becomes his most formidable adversary. The film satirizes the racism obscured by myth-making Hollywood accounts of the American West, with the hero being a black sheriff in an all-white town. The film is full of deliberate anachronisms, from the Count Basie Orchestra playing "April in Paris" in the Wild West, to Slim Pickens referring to the Wide World of Sports, to the German army of World War II.
- ▶ **The Wedding Plan** - At 32, Michal is finally looking forward to the comfort and security of marriage, when she is blindsided by her fiancé's decision to call off the wedding with only a month's notice. Unwilling to return to lonely single life, Michal decides to put her trust in fate and continue with her wedding plans, believing Mr. Right will appear by her chosen date. Nominated for eight and winner of four awards, including Best Actress, Best Screenplay, and Best Costume Design from the 2016 Israeli Film Academy.
- ▶ **Mr. Gaga** - Ohad Naharin, artistic director of the Batsheva Dance Company, is regarded as one of the important choreographers in the world. Meeting him at a critical turning point in his most personal life, this spirited and insightful documentary will introduce you to a man with great artistic integrity and an extraordinary vision. Filmed over a period of eight years, director Tomer Heymann mixes intimate rehearsal footage with an extensive unseen archive and breathtaking dance sequences. This story of an artistic genius who redefined the language of modern dance.

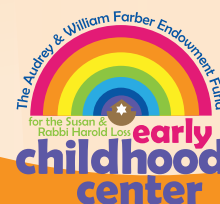

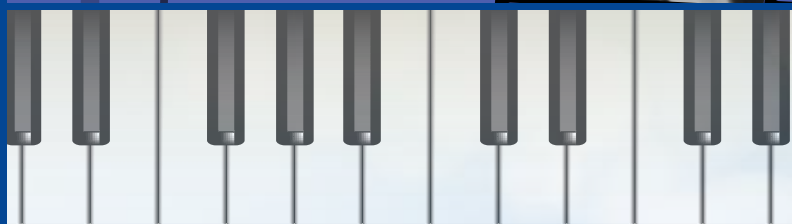
