# LOVING Music

If you have missed Cantor Michaels and myself around Temple's offices during July, that is because our music department has hunkered down at a Ferndale recording studio to create Temple Israel's next album of Kabbalat Shabbat music. Our first 2008 recording, *Kavanat Haruach*, introduced Temple's music to the Reform movement, was featured at Biennial, on the Reform movement's popular Ruach series and brought our compositions and sound to many synagogues around the country. In 2011, we released *We Are One*, celebrating the exciting sounds of Shabbat Unplugged. Once again, Temple's uplifting worship style reached shuls across the country as they adopted tunes from our own Rabbi Yedwab and co-composer Scott Stern.

We thank Sarah Gottlieb, as we remember also the generosity of her husband Harold<sup>271</sup> Gottlieb, who together made this amazing album possible in memory of their beloved son, Stephen. It will feature the next decade of familiar melodies from our Kabbalat Shabbat service in an inviting and high-octane album setting. We are thrilled to have Toronto's masterful Ari Posner producing our music out of his Toronto film and television soundtrack studio. Ari also spent a week in Michigan recording with some of the best studio musicians Detroit has to offer. You may have seen our music staff dancing around the studio joyfully on Instagram, and that is because the twelve tracks are a jubilant celebration of our Kabbalat Shabbat service, and sound as good as the best iTunes tracks we all love! Along with these local stars, we will have a true taste of Tel Aviv, with featured percussion from Hezi Yakov, one of the best darbuka players in Israel, who added some sensational licks and grooves from a brilliant studio in Israel.

Our album also presents a few new compositions that we are excited to release from both Ari and myself, as well as some tried and true Temple favorites by nationally known composers that have yet to be recorded at this kind of quality. As an added bonus, we are thrilled to have Temple's own Larry August donating his directorial expertise, and Hollywood caliber film production company to create a video of one of our songs that will make you smile and tap your toes.

Look out for a "record release" service this fall, where we will feature the studio musicians and album songs that you will be able to download for free from Temple's website, iTunes, or stream from Spotify, or Soundcloud. If you would like a good old CD to play, please call Temple once the album is out, and we will mail you your own copy.

We hope this project will be a treasured part of Temple's story, helping new members learn our melodies, inspiring families at special times, or just keeping you company in the car until we see you again on Friday night.



# HIGH HOLY DAYS

## IT'S TIME TO START THINKING ABOUT THE HIGH HOLY DAYS

### WHICH SERVICE IS RIGHT FOR YOUR FAMILY?

Adult Services are for adults and young adults who have attained Bar/Bat Mitzvah age.

Family Services are recommended for children who are 8 years old and above (or reading age) along with their parents and grandparents who are Temple Israel members. There will be a "Family Friendly" service for members eight and older on Kol Nidre. The service will be 7:15 - 8 pm in Korman Hall. This will be the ONLY Family Service on Kol Nidre.

Children's Services are geared to non-readers and their families and are recommended for children 8 years and under, along with parents and grandparents.

### YIZKOR (MEMORIAL) AND NEILAH (CONCLUDING) SERVICES

Our integrated Yizkor/Neilah Service will begin at 5:15 pm and conclude at 6:30 pm. Please do not bring a prayer book as one will be provided. An important aspect of the Yizkor service will be our Memorial Booklet. The names of those who have passed away on or since last Yom Kippur will be listed. Please note that these names will not be read aloud. It is important that we have the correct names. If you have a loved one whose name should be listed in this Memorial Booklet we urge you to contact the Temple office at 248-661-5700 or in advance of Rosh Hashanah to confirm the spelling of the name.

### HIGH HOLY DAY GUEST PASSES

Guest passes for visiting out-of-town family only will be available on request if seats are available. ALL families who wish to bring out-of-town guests to a High Holy Day service MUST complete and submit a Guest Request Form. Forms are mailed with your High Holy Days ticket information. Guest pass selections will be distributed on a first requested basis. *Requests for guest passes may necessitate your entire family being changed to a more available service.*

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### HOW DO I REQUEST TICKETS? WHEN WILL I GET MY FORMS?

By now you should have received your forms. Online registration is open. Services are processed on a first come, first served basis. A ticket request must be received to process your High Holy Days service selection. **Online membership account access is needed to request high holy day tickets via the website.**

### WHEN WILL MY HIGH HOLY DAYS TICKETS ARRIVE?

Watch your mailbox near the beginning of September for your tickets.

### HOW DO WE REGISTER FOR BABYSITTING DURING THE HIGH HOLY DAYS SERVICES?

A sitter service for children one year of age and older will be available at all High Holy Day services, except Children's Services, BY ADVANCE REGISTRATION ONLY. Complete the Babysitting Request Form online after you receive your High Holy Days tickets.

### HOW IS OUT OF TOWN SEATING REQUESTED?

If you will be out of town for the holidays and would like us to arrange for courtesy seating at another reform temple, please complete the RECIPROCITY REQUEST FORM online (available August 1). We will make every effort to secure reciprocity for Temple Israel members. For a list of reform congregations in your desired location, visit [congregations.urj.org](http://congregations.urj.org). Reciprocity is never easy at the last moment, so please complete the form as early as possible.

### ALL DAY ON YOM KIPPUR, INCLUDING SPECIAL AFTERNOON "MINCHA MOMENTS" SERVICE

Spiritually moving and intellectually stimulating study sessions will lead directly into our beautiful Yom Kippur Afternoon Service. Afternoon Mincha Moments services begin at 3:45 pm.

# HIGH HOLY DAYS (CONTINUED)

Inspired by the popular *Moth Radio Hour* (we call it the *Roth Radio Hour*), *Ted Talks* (we call it *Yed Talks*) and the *Chicago Ideas Week* (we call it “*Why Don’t You Move Back Home to Michigan Already?*”), MINCHA MOMENTS will once again be a Yom Kippur Afternoon Prayer Service like no other. Personal vignettes will punctuate a Yom Kippur afternoon prayer service that is poetically and musically inspiring.

As in years past, those who attend this afternoon service will have priority in terms of seating for the Yizkor/Neliah Service. For those who wish to remain at temple all day, it coordinates beautifully with our Yom Kippur morning services and study sessions. If you do stay all day, please park in the spaces designated for all-day worshipers.

Tickets are required. For more information please call the High Holy Days desk at Temple Israel, 248-661-5700.

## ALTERNATING SERMONS

When you come to our services on Kol Nidre, you will take a seat in either the Sanctuary or Herman Hall. The next day, those who were in the Sanctuary will worship in Herman Hall, and vice versa. This will allow you to worship with all our clergy and to hear each of the sermons.

## GET INVOLVED

High Holy Days will be here before you know it! We invite you to participate in our services this year. Opportunities include:

**CHANTING OR READING FROM THE TORAH:** You must be able to read Hebrew and able to work throughout the summer in preparation for services. You will receive a recording of your portion and will work with Carolyn Iwrey, our Service Coordinator.

**CHANTING TORAH AND HAFTARAH BLESSINGS:** The Torah Blessings are the same as the blessings you hear on Shabbat. The Haftarah Blessings, although similar to the Shabbat Blessings, are slightly different.

**HEBREW READING:** This reading is very short and does not involve chanting. You will receive a recording with the reading and should be able to learn this on your own.

**ENGLISH READING:** This reading will either be the English version of the Haftarah or an English prayer. You will receive a hard copy of your portion two or more weeks prior.

**TORAH CARRIER:** You will be given the honor of carrying the Torah during High Holiday Services. There is no speaking involved.

Requests must be completed by each family.**

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS

**FAMILY ADMITTANCE CARDS:** Please come to Temple Israel together as a family on the High Holy Days and display your family admittance cards to our ushers as you enter. At age 26, young people need to sign up for their own, independent membership and tickets. Please call Temple for details on our special, young adult membership plan or visit our Temple Israel website for details. Please note, all out of town guests will be included on your family admittance card.

**SEPARATE CARS:** We hope that your family will all arrive at Temple in one car. Parking is difficult for all synagogues during the High Holy Days. However, if you must drive separately we suggest that you simply arrange to meet at the doors and walk in together. Please keep in mind that Out of Town Guest Passes will be included on your Member High Holy Day Ticket.

**TALLIT:** We encourage you to wear your tallit at the Kol Nidre evening service and at any morning service.

**HANDICAPPED STICKERS:** Please display any handicapped stickers so our parking lot attendants can see them clearly.

**LIVE STREAMING SERVICES:** If you cannot be here in person for High Holy Days services, we will bring the services to you! We offer Live Streaming on our website.

If you missed these films at the Lenore Marwil Jewish Film Festival in the spring, check them out from the Hodari Family Library and Media Center:


- ▶ **Bag of Marbles** - This is the true story of two young Jewish brothers in German occupied France who, with a mind-boggling mix of mischievousness, courage and ingenuity, will be forced to fend for themselves in order to survive the enemy invasion and try to bring their family back together.
- ▶ **Including Samuel** - Before his son Samuel was diagnosed with cerebral palsy, photojournalist Dan Habib rarely thought about how to include people with disabilities in the mainstream of modern life. Now he thinks about inclusion every day. This award-winning documentary passionately chronicles the family's hopes for Samuel, their work to overcome challenges, and their efforts to include Samuel in every facet of their lives. Through interviews with peers, teachers, parents, and disability rights experts, the film explores the world of inclusion and education.

- ▶ **Itzhak** - From Schubert to Strauss, Bach to... Billy Joel, Itzhak Perlman's transcendent violin playing evokes the depth of the human experience. This film details the virtuoso's own struggles as a polio survivor and Jewish émigré, and reminds us why art is vital to life.
- ▶ **The Last Suit** - At 88, Abraham Bursztein, a Jewish tailor, runs away from Buenos Aires to Poland to find a friend who saved him from certain death at the end of World War II. After seven decades with no contact, Abraham will try to find his old friend and keep his promise to return one day.
- ▶ **Longing** - A middle-aged Israeli bachelor is forced to evaluate his life choices when he discovers an ex-girlfriend gave birth to his son 20 years before. This is a story about parenthood, about the desire to be a parent, and the hidden aspects of parenthood.


#### Other films to Check Out:

- ▶ **Cupcakes** - An extravagant and unashamedly entertaining Eurovision parody featuring a feel-good soundtrack. Set in contemporary Tel Aviv, six diverse best friends gather to watch the wildly popular UniverSong competition. Appalled by the Israeli entry, they decide to create their own and record it on a mobile phone. Unbeknownst to them, their performance is seen by the UniverSong judges and selected as Israel's entry for next year's competition. With bright, Almodovar-esque styling irresistibly catchy tunes and a gloriously uplifting storyline, this laugh-out-loud comedy is a refreshing ode to music, friendship and romance.
- ▶ **Wish I Was Here** - From Zach Braff, the creator of Garden State, comes this touching and funny story about being a parent, spouse and child- all at the once. Aidan Bloom (Braff), a husband and father of two, is set on pursuing his dream as an actor when his father (Mandy Patinkin) reveals he's battling a serious illness. As the announcement disrupts Aidan's day-to-day existence, his decision to homeschool his children will lead him on an unexpected journey of discovery about fulfillment and family.
- ▶ **The Infidel** - Meet Mahmud Nasir, loving husband, doting father and something of a "relaxed" Muslim. He may not be the most observant, but in his heart he is a true Muslim. After his mother's death, Mahmud finds his birth certificate, which reveals that he was adopted at birth and ....He's JEWISH! As Mahmud tumbles headlong into a full-scale identity crisis, the only person he can turn to is Lenny, a drunken Jewish cabbie. Soon Mahmud is embarking on lessons in Jewishness.


