# SONG: THE ULTIMATE ANTI-DEPRESSANT

This week we celebrate Shabbat Shira - the Sabbath of Song. Each year in the middle of winter, we are called upon to hear the singing voices of liberation, the voices of our ancestors who stood at the shore of the sea. After generations of sadness and depression, of what seemed like a certain death of the

spirit, the Israelites suddenly break into song and renew their spiritual quest for meaning and significance.

Shabbat Shira is one of the few Shabbatot that have a specific name. It is in this week's Torah portion, B'shalach, that we find the ancient Israelites' destiny finally revealed. If you were to look in the Torah at this week's portion, you would find something unlike any other in the scroll - a section set apart chanted with its own melody, a mosaic of words and poetry - a song. This is called Shirat Hayam, the Song of the Sea. It is the primal outpouring of music that bursts forth from our peoples' collective soul having crossed the Red Sea, released from slavery to freedom.

It is the *Shira* (the Song) that gets top billing because our sages recognized that song is the most liberating of all activities. Song is the medium that uplifts the soul from the mundane to the holy.

A colleague of mine once told me that "those who sing prays twice." It's true. Those who sing do pray twice -- first, to express a yearning to be free; and a second time to celebrate the freedom that has been attained. This song is recited every day in the traditional morning service; a phrase of it is found in the prayer of redemption immediately after the Shema, known to nearly all Jews: "Mi Chamocha Ba'elim Adonai" – who is like You among gods that are worshipped? We remember our ancestors, who yearned to be free, and we celebrate their liberation and ours.

As many have considered, song is at the core of human creativity, a crucial aspect of our learning, worship and faith community. For song opens our hearts. We sing for joy, but we also sing in lament; song captures our innermost feelings and yearnings. Such is the *raison d'être* for this year's Laker concert artists, **Six13**. Six13 is a groundbreaking, six-man a cappella vocal band that is bringing an unprecedented style and energy to Jewish music, with nothing but the power of the human voice.

Juxtaposing the traditional and the contemporary, Six13 is anchored by a strong Jewish identity, fueled by soulful harmonies, intricate arrangements and their signature dynamic, full-band-like sound, and driven by a mission to connect Jews around the world with their heritage through music.

The New York City-based group is an international phenomenon both online, where their videos have been viewed over 15 million times, and in traditional media, having been featured in national television and press like The Today Show, CNN, Huffington Post, Time Magazine and more. They performed at the White House for a private audience of President Barack Obama, First Lady Michelle Obama and Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg. Bruno Mars liked their Passover version of his song so much, he posted it on his own Facebook page.

Be sure to save **Sunday, April 26<sup>th</sup> at 4 pm** on your calendars when Temple Israel will host the amazing Six13 (see pg 17 for details).

The celebration of song will only continue as we usher in the month of May with a full-scale Broadway show, **Children of Eden**, featuring talent of all ages from within our congregation and presented in our very own Sanctuary!

Based on the story of Genesis, the age-old conflict of parents and children takes the bimah in this epic, heartfelt musical from theatre legend, Stephen Schwartz (of "Wicked" fame). Join us on **Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7 pm** and **Sunday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> at 2 pm** as we take on the story of the Old Testament in this moving, foot-stomping musical, produced and directed by Stephanie Michaels' Ignite Productions, and powered by Temple Israel and the Ethel Hyman and Rose Kaplan Foundation.

This Shabbat Shira, may we all hear the song of the universe, celebrating the beauty and wonder around us, and add our own notes to create an even more wonderful and lasting harmony.

### WHAT IS THIS ELECTION ABOUT?

The World Zionist Congress (WZC) meets every 5 years to establish policies for Israeli society. Jews from around the world vote for a slate that represents their values and determines how 1 billion dollars will be allocated.

### HOW CAN I VOTE FOR REFORM VALUES?

The Vote Reform slate will prioritize and provide financial support to pluralism, equality, tolerance and inclusion in Israel, including:

### WHEN CAN I VOTE?

### WHO CAN VOTE?

Anyone who identifies as Jewish, is over the age of 18 (as of June 30, 2020), and lives in the U.S. (note: dual citizens of Israel and the U.S. who did not vote in the last Israeli election are eligible).

#### **Chuck Fishman Exhibit**

The photographs in the exhibit are drawn from and supplementing Chuck Fishman's book, Polish Jews: The Final Chapter (1977), it presents an in-depth, photographic look at the state of Jewish life in Poland from the mid-1970s to 2016, a dwindling remnant of a once vibrant community. Jews had survived near-annihilation under Nazism.

With the passing of four decades, however, the narrative has radically changed. The fall of Communism has engendered a transformative rebirth, a 'return to identity' among many young Poles discovering hidden Jewish roots. The renewal of Jewish life in Poland is an extraordinary story that has its roots in the preservation and continuation of Jewish life under Communism.
