It has been said many times before, “but it was truly a bizarre spring.” For us, in the education departments at Temple Israel, it was especially strange for Jewish learning. Overnight, the teachers in our Tyner Religious School and Rabbi Harold and Susan Loss Early Childhood Center had to adapt lesson plans, learn how to do Zoom, create bags of crafts, rummage through their personal libraries, and figure out new ways of connecting with their students

while providing meaningful educational experiences. And adapt they did...with gusto! Each day I was more impressed with the lengths our teachers went to in order to help their students remain engaged and learning.

As teachers and as administrators, we also learned a lot this spring. Many of us were novices to Zoom and are now experts! We discovered that learning Hebrew one-on-one with a teacher over FaceTime is a very effective way to make sure that each student gets the needed individualized attention. We learned that community can be created through a screen but that students do have a limited screen time capacity. And most of all we realized just how much we love our teachers, our students, and our community...and how much we miss them when we cannot be together in person.

We are taking all that we learned over the past several months and using that new knowledge to create enhanced learning opportunities. Though the school year is over, our programming is not. We have held amazing Religious School Zoom hangouts spending time making sand art projects, baking, playing games and checking in. Throughout the month of July our Religious School students can play a Summertime Jewish Bingo to stay engaged with Temple Israel. Our ECC students have virtual programs each week to hear stories, sing and pray. We are always planning other activities and programs to stay connected to all of our students!

Though we still have much happening, we know that what you are most interested in is what will happen in the fall? We are working to create high quality programming that maintains the health and safety of our students and staff while also allowing for flexibility.

We are constantly engaged in conversation with colleagues locally and nationwide as well as medical professionals so that you can be assured that our curricula will balance Jewish values with the physical and mental health needs of our community.

Parents recently received surveys from both the ECC and the Religious School asking for feedback regarding fall planning. Parents, you truly are our partner in educating your children. It is so important that you share your thoughts, questions, and concerns with us so that your voice is heard as we plan for our fall programs.

We will continue to update you throughout the summer regarding our fall plans. Until then, enjoy the sunshine and stay safe. Hoping to see you soon!
