Since then, the Kaftan family has been lighting candles every week. When Gloria was dying from cancer, Rabbi Loss talked about the essence of "being Jewish" and Mel Kaftan, son of Gloria & Allen, immediately knew what to do to perpetuate the memory of his parents. #### ANNE & EDWARD FIENMAN COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP FUND
