In order for students to be successful, there are responsibilities that we will fulfill as a school staff and there are responsibilities that we ask families to commit to. Our Responsibilities as a School Staff:

- Implement high quality, engaging Jewish education each week for all Kindergarten through Sixth Grade students
- Provide musical experiences each week exposing students to prayer and Jewish songs
- Provide all supplies and learning materials needed for lessons and projects
- Provide highly trained teachers and Madrichim (teen leaders) in every classroom
- Communicate with families on a regular basis regarding upcoming events and classroom happenings
- Implement safety procedures to keep all students and staff safe
- Engage in ongoing professional development to stay up to date on topics and teaching techniques

Responsibilities of Families:

- Help students have consistent attendance to maximize learning at Religious School
- Discuss the importance of giving tzedakah (money to charity) with students and encourage their participation in class each week
- Communicate with staff regularly throughout the year regarding students' learning needs, allergies, and medical needs
- Participate in Family Education programs throughout the school year
- Reinforce our school policies regarding no cell phone usage during class
- Reinforce our policy of reflecting the value of "Kavod La'Briot" - respect and honor of every human being (bullying behavior of any kind will not be tolerated)
- Help students dress appropriately for Religious School each week (modest clothing)
- Be respectful of other students' allergies by keeping all food and drinks at home (Please contact the office if your child needs food or drink for a medical reason.)
- Keep the office up to date on any information changes (Ex: phone number, e-mail, address)
- Comply with our arrival and dismissal procedures (Arrival-through Tyner entrance doors; Dismissal-Grades K-3 parent pick up in the classrooms, Grades 4-6 leave through the sanctuary doors to the car line)
- Provide a note to the office when your child needs to be dismissed early from school
- Reinforce learning of school taught topics at home
