Dr. Naomi Grunhaus is Associate Professor in the  
Rebecca Ivry Department of Jewish Studies at Stern

almost twenty years. She has twice received a Ms. E.  
Billi Ivry Faculty Research Incentive Award and was  
also the recipient of the Murray and Madeleine  
Baumel Faculty Incentive Award. Her book on the  
interplay between peshat and derash in Radak's  
biblical commentaries was published in 2012 by Oxford  
University Press. Dr. Grunhaus is a frequent presenter  
at scholarly conferences, in the U.S. and abroad. She  
has also authored scholarly articles, book reviews, and  
encyclopedia entries. Dr. Grunhaus received her PhD in  
Jewish Studies from New York University, MA and MS  
degrees from New York University, and a BS from  
Brooklyn College.
