## Rabbi Daniel Feldman to Analyze Impacts of Technology, Daf Yomi Group to Celebrate Siyum at Seudah Shlisheet

Suppose you were faced with multiple simultaneous *mitzva* opportunities: attending a *shiur* by a noted *rosh yeshiva*, participating in the *seudat mitzva* of a *siyum*, and eating the obligatory *Shabbat seudah shlisheet*. Which takes precedence? The question is moot because this *Shabbat* afternoon we have the good fortune to be able to do all three in our social hall, following *mincha*.



This *Shabbat* the Adult Education Committee is hosting Rabbi Daniel Z. Feldman who will deliver two *shiurim*. The first, at 6:00 pm in our New Main, is entitled “*Shabbat in Outer Space and its Implications for Us Back on Earth*.” The second *shiur* will be at a special *seudat shlisheet*, following the 6:50 *mincha*. The topic will be “Technology, Surveillance, and the Ethics of Personal Privacy.”

Rabbi Feldman is a *rosh yeshiva* at the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary at Yeshiva University, as well as an instructor at the Sy Syms School of Business and the Wurzweiler School of Social Work and serves as the Executive Editor of the RIETS initiative of YU Press. A frequent lecturer across America and abroad, Rabbi Feldman is a noted author, co-editor of more than ten volumes of Talmudic essays and Jewish thought and serves on the editorial board of Tradition. Rabbi Feldman is the spiritual leader of Ohr Saadya of Teaneck, where he resides with his wife, Leah, and their children.

Also, this *Shabbat*, our *Daf Yomi* group completes its study of the tractate of *Zevachim*. They will mark the occasion with a *seudat mitzva* and are excited to celebrate with the entire congregation, hoping that more members might join their group as they begin the tractate of *Menachot* on Sunday morning. *Menachot* deals with sacrifices brought in the *Beit Hamikdash*, but also details the laws of *mezuzah*, *tefillin*, and *tzitzit*.

Unlike most *Daf Yomi* groups, Bnai Yeshurun's does not have a designated *maggid shiur*, who teaches the *daf* every day. Rather, there is a group of about fifteen *maggidei shiur*, each of whom prepares and teaches the *daf* once every two weeks. For a number of years, Manny Adler has been teaching the *daf* every *Shabbat*, once before the morning *Nusach Sefard minyan* and again before *mincha*. Manny will formally finish *Zevachim* at the *seudat shlisheet*. **Continued on page 4**

Another unique aspect of our shul's *Daf Yomi* study is the daily presence and participation of Rabbi Shlomo Weinberger, עמרי"ש (see photo), whose erudition and determination inspire the group and motivate every other *maggid shiur* to prepare a little more thoroughly. When the group gets "stuck," Rabbi Weinberger is there to "unstuck" them and if a *maggid shiur* misinterprets the *gemara*, Rabbi Weinberger is there to assist him, occasionally with refreshing candor.

This week's integrated *seudah shlisheet*, *shiur*, and *siyum* is a wonderful example of what can be done when our dedicated committee chairs and *baalei batim* work together to make us greater than the sum of our parts. Their efforts should be recognized. Rabbi Yoseph Siev has been involved with our Adult Ed program for 30 years, the last 20 as chairman or co-chair. David Chesir serves as co-chair and Ira Jaskoll and Sandy Gross are recent additions to the committee. Adult Ed organizes 10 to 15 programs each year to enhance the Bnai Yeshurun Experience. (The committee is eager to add additional, younger members, to help appeal to our shul's younger demographic. If interested, please contact Rabbi Siev.)

Dovid Weinstein chairs our *Seudah Shlisheet* committee, with the assistance of Yitz Norman. Dovid has been leading this effort for nearly ten years. He would like to increase the frequency at which we join together for a *seudah shlisheet*, institute more robust *zemirots*, and find ways to increase our communal *oneg Shabbat*. Dovid would welcome additional volunteers to his committee.
