## A Very Special CBY Experience: Manny Freed z'l Parent Child Learning

Central to our lives as Jews is the concept of **מסורה**, sharing our religious heritage with our children and grandchildren. It is an extension of the experience at Mt. Sinai. It goes beyond transmitting historical facts and halachic obligations and strictures. It is becoming a link in the **שלשלת**, in the generation-to-generation chain that is the existential enabler of Jewish continuity and vibrancy.

About a dozen years ago, our Beis Medrash Program initiated a modest effort to encourage parents to spend an hour studying Torah with their young children on *Shabbat* afternoons (or on Saturday evenings on short winter *Shabbatot*). About six years ago, the program was dedicated by the Weinberger family in memory of Manny Freed z'l. Week after week, year after year, the program and participation have grown. If you want to observe **מסורה** in action, if you want to see and participate in the formation and forging of new links in the **שלשלת**, take your child or grandchild (or borrow a niece or nephew) and spend one hour at the Manny Freed z'l Parent Child Learning (MFPCCL) on the **מוצאי שבת** in our **מדרש**.

You will see on the order of 120 of our youngsters listening and asking and learning and exploring. You will observe them bonding with their parents and grandparents, typically about 60 adults. They will be snacking on all manner of *nosh* and devouring slices of pizza, but all the while learning and growing through **תלמוד תורה**. And then the Beis Medrash will get surprisingly quiet as everyone listens to Rabbi Zahtz explain some aspect of the weekly *parsha*. Finally, it's time for the raffle, as Rabbi Zahtz dramatically fishes ticket after ticket from the bowl and the winners excitedly claim their prizes and the "losers" learn a critical life lesson: *Azoy geht es!* You don't always win.

The founders and core families who created and nurtured MFPCCL see it as a powerful vehicle in defining their relationship with their children and in transforming
