"And you shall take for yourselves on the first day the fruit of beautiful trees..."

It's a busy time of the year for Arturo Stern. It is not easy to harvest and package 400 *etrogim* and *lulavim*. Fortunately for Arturo, he does not have to do those tasks. What he does, though, is provide CBY members with a unique opportunity to acquire beautiful *arba minim* sets, at competitive prices, and with the utmost convenience. Arturo has been providing that service for about twenty-five years and he is quick to thank his long-time team members David Carr, Michel Werblowsky, Ira Jaskoll, Rabbi Jonathan Schachter, Yoni Nagler, and Irv Klavan. He also notes that CBY Bookkeeper Galina Staroff has always been very helpful in keeping track of all the financial details associated with this project.



Arturo traces his career in the *arba minim* business to his experiences as an entrepreneurial teenager in Yeshiva Torah VoDaath. At the age of fifteen, Arturo would take the subway from his dormitory in Williamsburg to Yonkers. He would travel with a large suitcase, scissors and a very large knife. In Yonkers, he would climb trees looking for the most beautiful *aravot*, fill his

suitcase and carry them back to Brooklyn. His beautiful produce would command high prices and he "really could make a lot of money in just a couple of days." If you want a good laugh, ask Arturo about the time he was apprehended by undercover policemen who stopped him hurrying through the streets of Williamsburg with a suitcase full of *aravot* and a very large knife.

Today, his *arba minim* business still makes money, but now Bnai Yeshurun and its members are the beneficiaries. Initially, Arturo would purchase *lulavim* and *etrogim* from various suppliers but, in recent years, he created a win-win partnership with Reuven Nayowitz to leverage the volume purchases of the Judaica House. Even after providing members with high-quality produce at a competitive price, the annual project provides income of \$8,000 or more to the shul.

Each year, CBY members buy about 270 sets through Arturo but he actually purchases and displays about 400 sets so that members have a real choice. (Unsold sets are returned to the Judaica House where they can be sold or returned to suppliers.) Arturo points out that there is probably no other venue where you can personally examine so many *etrogim* and *lulavim* before making your own personal choice. Furthermore, one of our rabbis will be there to assist you if you have any questions. All of the *etrogim* are imported from Israel, while the *lulavim* come from El Arish in Egypt.

This year, because of the way the *Yomim Tovim* fall, pickup of your *arba minim* will be on Thursday evening, September 20th, though *Sukkot* does not begin until the following Monday.

CBY and OU Women's Initiative: 21st Century Teshuva – This Sunday

On Sunday morning, September 16th, Bnai Yeshurun will host 21st



Century Teshuva, with Sivan Rahav Meir (see photo), one of Israel's most popular media personalities. The program, described as *A Synergy of Media and Meaning*, will begin at 10 am, & is open to men & women. It is sponsored by the OU's Women's Initiative which is implementing national programming for women of all ages and stages of life to help each

woman find her personal and communal leadership voice.

Ms. Meir is a prime-time anchor on Channel 2 News; has a column in Israel's, *Yediot Aharonot*; & has a weekly radio show on *Galei Tzahal*. She has been working in the Israeli media since the age of six & became Orthodox as a teenager. One of the very few public intellectuals who is well respected across the religious-secular spectrum, Ms. Meir has attracted a very large following on social media for her insights into Jewish life & tradition.

How can you keep your *arba minim* fresh for as long as possible? Arturo offers the following advice:

- Don't worry about your *etrog*. It will be fine.
- Don't open the sealed packages of *hadassim* and *aravot* until just before the *chag*. Until then, keep them in the refrigerator or in a cool place in your basement.
- Don't (surprise!) get the *hadassim*, *aravot* and the *lulav* wet. Rather, wrap them in aluminum foil and put a moist towel around the foil. Direct contact with water will accelerate the growth of mold.
- No matter what you do, the *aravot* will dry up and deteriorate during the course of the *chag*.

For those who have already ordered *arba minim* sets from the shul, please remember that pickup is this Thursday evening in our Social Hall. If you have not placed your order you may still do so on the CBY website through Monday, or just show up anyway because it is likely that Arturo and his team will be able to exceed your expectations.
