Lee Weinblatt's Artistic Photographs Enhance the Bnai Yeshurun Experience

If, as they say, "A picture is worth a thousand words," and since over 300 different pictures by Lee Weinblatt have adorned the walls of Bnai Yeshurun over the past 22 years, it will be difficult to do justice to Lee's one-man CBY "Beautification Project." Most of Lee's moving photos of Israel had to be removed when refurbishment of our lobbies began a couple of months ago. But they are back! They are now prominently displayed in a gallery beginning at the Jefferson Avenue entrance and extending through the hallway to our main lobby.

It all began in about 1996 when Joey Bench and Lee spearheaded our shul's expansion project. Lee explains that one of their primary objectives was to "bring Bnai Yeshurun to Israel and bring Israel to Bnai Yeshurun." That led to critical design elements, such as the Jerusalem stone wall in the New Main and Lee's large photographic rendering of the *Kotel* in our lobby, both of which have helped shape the "look and feel" of our shul.

If you look carefully you will see that Lee's *Kotel* photo had to be printed in four separate sections and then precisely aligned to give the desired effect. Families who celebrate weekday *smachot* in our building generally take a whole series of family photos with Lee's *Kotel* in the background. The "mini menorahs" around the *Kotel* were designed by Lee to echo the *menorahs* at the actual *Kotel* plaza.

Another one of Lee's favorite photos is the one that captures the excitement of a *vatikin minyan* at the *Kotel* on the morning of *Hoshanna Rabbah*. He used a huge Widelux fully mechanical swing-lens panoramic camera and got special permission to go to the top of Aish HaTorah (then under construction) and hung over a railing at 5 am, waiting for the precise moment that the sun peeked over the horizon.

Many have joked that they recognize themselves or their children in the picture (which has over 25,000 people in the crowd), but the fact is that it's an 800,000,000-pixel photo and if it were sufficiently enlarged you would be able to recognize individual faces.

Most of our members are familiar with Lee's skills and interest in photography. (He started at age 9 when he got a free camera for opening a \$10 bank account and he holds over 50 patents for camera and video technology.) But relative newcomers may not know that Lee was our shul's president in 1980-82, a very active administration during which both the CBY expansion and the building of the Teaneck *mikva* were approved (the first by the membership, the second by an independent committee). The Weinblatts have been CBY members since they first moved to Teaneck in 1971, almost half a century ago.

Lee acknowledges that he gets special *nachas* when he makes new acquaintances in his travels in the United States and Israel. When they inquire as to the shul in which he *davens*, he answers, "Bnai Yeshurun." And often they exclaim, "Oh, I know that shul. It's the one with all the pictures of Israel!" (Those pictures are worth more than a thousand words each, but you'll have to settle for a total of 576.)
