## Rabbi Dr. Ephraim Kanarfogel CBY Scholar in Residence

"From Moshe (Rabbeinu) Until Moshe (Maimonides) There Was None Like Moshe." That is the inscription on the tomb of the Rambam. His genius and monumental codification of Jewish law were already recognized by his contemporaries. Why then did Ashkenazic *Rishonim* ignore the Rambam? Come tonight and find out. At a 9:00 pm *Oneg Shabbat* this evening (Friday, October 19) in the CBY Social Hall Rabbi Dr. Ephraim Kanarfogel will address this fascinating question.

This *Shabbat*, Rabbi Kanarfogel is serving as our Joseph N. Muschel Scholar in Residence. Tomorrow, he will deliver a talk entitled, *Dreams as a Determinant of Jewish Law and Practice in Medieval Europe*, in the New Main, following *davening* (about 11 am). After *mincha* tomorrow, Rabbi Kanarfogel's topic will be *Precedent and Innovation in the Halachic Process: Medieval Models and the Implications for Modernity*.



CBY Scholar in Residence Rabbi Dr. Ephraim Kanarfogel

Having served as spiritual leader of Teaneck's Congregation Beth Aaron from 1984 to 2003 and still a local resident, our Scholar in Residence is well known by many in our community. Currently, he is the E. Billi Ivry University Professor of Jewish History, Literature and Law at Yeshiva University's Bernard Revel Graduate School of Jewish Studies. He has authored or edited eight books and published ninety articles and reviews. His most recent book, *The Intellectual History and Rabbinic Culture of Medieval Ashkenaz*, won the Goldstein-Goren International Book Award and the Jordan Schnitzer Book Prize from the Association of Jewish Studies.
