New CBY Objective: Better Communications

That the words "community" and "communication" are so integrally related should surprise no one, the latter being the bedrock on which the former is built. The words קהילה and קהל appear to be rooted in the word קול, *voice*, perhaps because people were called together to form a congregation or because, again, it is the voice, a vehicle for communication, that creates community.

The improvement of all aspects of our shul's communications was a key objective that emerged when our newly-elected officers first met in June. They recognized that there had been occasional disconnects between what the shul's lay leadership thought was in the shul's best interests and what a substantial number of our members wanted. They also felt that many members were unaware of many shul activities and did not appreciate how fortunate we are to be a part of an incredible institution.

As a result, a small, core team was chartered with improving all aspects of Bnai Yeshurun communication. The team's initial recommendations are already being implemented and an enhanced weekly Shabbat bulletin (which you are reading) is but one element in a multi-faceted plan. The intent, each week, is to let you know "what's happening." Next week, we will, IY"Y, tell you what occurred at the July board meeting.

You may have already noticed increased coverage of Bnai Yeshurun in the local Jewish press. Two electronic displays, one for our upper and one for our lower lobby, have been ordered and a couple of poster display boards were installed last week. We will reinstitute a printed shul bulletin (bi-monthly) with messages from both our rabbinic and lay leadership and containing much more extensive coverage of shul activities (both prospective and retrospective). The first issue will be published before ראש השנה. Our shul website (www.bnaiyeshurun.org) and Facebook page are up and running and will continue to improve in response to your input. Planning has started for a two-way communications tool with which members can ask questions or make recommendations and can expect a rapid response, the goal being less than 48 hours.

As he does after each shul election, Rabbi Pruzansky briefly addressed the newly-elected officers and directors at their first meeting with words of חיזוק and encouragement. But the main thrust of his message was the need for communication - between members of the Board and the Rabbi as well as with all the members of the shul. He further requested that the Board convey that message to the membership, that the Rabbi's "door is always open" and that members should never hesitate to contact him, by email, by text message, or, best of all- "just pick up the phone and call."

Our initial core communication team consists of Executive Director Elysia Stein, Shul Administrator, Elizabeth Naor, Yali Elkin and David Zomick. Please contact any of them or any of your elected representatives with suggestions and comments, not just about this new weekly format but about how to communicate more effectively, thereby enhancing the Bnai Yeshurun community.

This past Tuesday evening, Bnai Yeshurun hosted a lecture by Rabbi Hershel Becker, spiritual leader of the Young Israel of Kendall in Florida. His topic: Relationships: It's a Choice.
