## CBY Beis Medrash Program Returns With Additional Torah Study Offerings

WARNING: If the Beis Medrash Program (BMP) Committee has its way, you may soon be hard pressed to find excuses to not spend a little more time in Torah study. In addition to the full schedule of *shiurim* which resumes after *Sukkot*,



Committee Chair Daniel Gibber (see photo), along with committee members Henry Orlinsky, Danny Saks, Steven Becker, Dovid Weinstein, and Moshe Zwebner are planning a number of innovations to help members "get with the program."

Each weekday evening, from 8 to 10 pm, there will be a *rav* in our Beis Medrash to encourage and facilitate Torah study. Rabbi Yosef Weinberger (on Mondays) and Rabbi Jason Finkelstein (Tuesday through Thursday) will teach 30-40 minute *chavurahs*, help arrange *chavrusahs*, and serve as a *chavrusah* (your own personal consultant) in support of whatever you choose to study. The final list of *chavurahs* is still being prepared but it will likely include such subjects as *Mishnah B'rurah*, the *Chofetz Chaim*, pearls of חסידות, and the writings of the Rambam.

The committee hopes to turn some of our legal holidays into *shiur*, days of concentrated study on specific themes. Having successfully demonstrated the community's interest in attending a *shiur* by Rav Moshe Weinberger two weeks ago (see photo on pg. 4), the committee is "in negotiations" with a number of renowned Torah personalities to arrange for them to teach and inspire us.

One of the challenges facing the committee is funding. The shul operating budget pays only about 25% of BMP costs; the remainder is covered through sponsorships and special donations. Moshe Zwebner recently joined the committee to develop a more predictable funding stream and to solicit wider support by our membership.

Daniel is quick to credit current and former members of the BMP Committee for their foresight and conviction in developing our current array of *shiurim*. The committee was started nearly 30 years ago when we expanded into our current facility. **Continued on page 4**
