CBY Beis Medrash Library: Critical Asset & Major Challenge

Bnai Yeshurun is fortunate to have one of the most beautiful and well-stocked Judaica libraries in our area. Containing on the order of 6,000 volumes, our expanded and refurbished Beis Medrash library houses all the traditional classic *seforim* and a wide assortment of contemporary works (in English and Hebrew) on *Shabbat*, our various *Yomim Tovim*, Business Ethics, Medicine, Jewish Family Life, etc.

Our Chief (and only) Librarian for the past six years is Dr Jerry Weinberg. Despite his busy medical practice as an ophthalmologist (in Brooklyn!), Jerry tries to spend time in our Beis Medrash every day, pursuing his own Torah studies, assisting others in their use of the library and attending to all the mundane tasks associated with maintaining and upgrading the large collection of *seforim*.

In analyzing why he devotes so much time and effort to our library, Jerry explains, "It's hard to articulate, but I just love *seforim*. It's an interest that developed later in life, maybe 25 years ago. I also enjoy helping others learn to use our library's assets. I get a certain satisfaction in organizing things. When I was a kid, I liked organizing stamps and coins. The library seems to be able to channel my interests and certain aspects of my personality."

Jerry explains that the collection is focused on usage- which are the books that people will really use? In recent years, as more members of Sephardic background have joined CBY, we've responded to their requests to acquire a number of the classic *seforim* from the distinguished Sephardic heritage.

Since becoming our shul librarian, Jerry has made several innovations. He created the "*Shaimos* (sic) Foundation." When old *seforim* are left at the shul as *sheimot* and Jerry believes that some of the volumes being discarded may be of interest to others, he organizes a *seforim* sale, the proceeds of which are used to buy new books for the library. These sales have also allowed our college and high school students to acquire *seforim* at a very nominal cost.

Jerry also started a "New Book Section" (in the center of the back wall of the Beis Medrash). This allows library users to peruse new publications and, in many cases, has led to members buying their own copies for their home libraries. **Continued on page 4**

Several years ago, the family and friends of Naomi Freedman a"h established a lending library in her memory. Located in our Old Main Shul

and also under Jerry's purview, that library was recently enhanced by a substantial contribution of volumes by Allan Freedman and Sorah and Howard Birnbaum. Operating on an honor system, books may be borrowed from that library for up to three weeks.

Jerry asks for our members' assistance in three matters. First, please do not remove library *seforim* from the shul building. Too often people forget to return them and, in any event, when they are out, fellow members are deprived of their use. Replacing individual missing volumes can be very expensive.

Second, please do not use the Beis Medrash as a depository for *sheimot* or as a new home for your excess *seforim*. If you have books that you want to donate, please discuss with Jerry before bringing them to shul.

Finally, after using a *sefer*, please return it to the spot from which you took it. Do not leave it on the tables or in the general vicinity of where you found the book. Please do not change the way the *seforim* are organized. Please don't insert a *siddur* or *chumash* on the book shelves near your seat for your personal convenience.

Our librarian extends thanks "to the elves," to the small cadre of members who quietly and anonymously find *seforim* out of place and restock them correctly, who daily clean up the empty coffee cups or the discarded *shiur* notes, and who try in various ways to make the library inviting and easy to use. Jerry is looking for a few volunteers. Perhaps you'd like to help create a catalog or library map or to assume "ownership" for maintaining a small subsection of the library. It could be a great learning experience for anyone who wants to extend their knowledge of *halachic* literature, or Jewish history, etc. Your role will be tailored to your availability and interests. If you're not yet familiar with the library, Jerry will be happy to show you around. The Beis Medrash and its contents are open to our members and the entire community from 6 am until about 11 pm, 7 days a week.
