Board Addresses Critical Issues and Assesses Budget Impact

At its July Meeting, our Board of Directors addressed three critical issues: our shul's youth programs, the physical security of our facility, and potential new sources of revenue.

For the last six weeks, Chaya Schwartz (see photo), Sari Sheinfeld and Henry Orlinsky have been leading a team, focused on our shul's youth programs. In addition to being an important element in the growth of our children, our youth program can be a factor when new Teaneck residents decide which shul to join. The team is being expanded to include not only our Youth Committee and Youth Director but by "new sets of eyes," a group of about ten other members, most of whom have significant experience in education. The team has observed our programs and spent considerable time consulting with the youth activity leadership at other area synagogues and observing their activities in session.



While the analysis and planning are still on-going, preliminary findings are emerging. On the positive side, our Youth Director seems to be doing a good job of welcoming and integrating new participants into our programs. Two important shortcomings have also emerged. Our youth rooms are smaller and less attractive than those of other local shuls. More important, our youth leaders are younger and less experienced, and management of the more successful programs is by two co-directors, rather than by a single director. We also want to strengthen the educational aspects in future programming. The Board was in agreement that we should try to close these evident gaps.

Partial funding for refurbishment of our youth rooms can be handled within the approved capital expense and maintenance budgets and was approved by the Board. Hiring a co-director for the youth program would have to be considered by the general membership since it was not in the approved budget. The Board authorized the president to develop a voluntary fundraising initiative to cover any potential shortfall for this fiscal year. It is hoped that members will participate enthusiastically in this voluntary, but important effort. If we secure both the funding and an exciting candidate, we will assess the impact on the program & report to the membership at the December meeting. If successful, the increased salary costs will be included in the next annual plan & the entire membership can approve or disapprove.

Adam Pfefer (see photo), Adam Hirsch, & Ronny Apfel then presented the status & plans of our Security Committee. Over the past several years, great progress has been made using Homeland Security grants & our own 24-member team of volunteers. A new lockdown system has been installed to limit our exposure if an attacker (Heaven forbid) entered our facility. **Continued on page 4**

The Security Team's biggest concern is that there are times during the week when the shul is heavily populated but during which we have absolutely no police or armed guard presence. These times include *Erev Shabbat*, *Shabbat* afternoons, and the first few hours every day. The team presented three options, whose costs ranged from about \$20K to well over \$100K per year.

Not only are these increased costs not in the approved budget, but some options entail having armed guards within our building, an aspect that some have objected to in the past. The Board approved a small expenditure increase for a police presence during especially high usage times but asked the team to continue its analysis and the dialog it has started with other large NY-NJ area shuls. The committee will report to the congregation at the General Membership Meeting in December.

Treasurer Andy Berkowitz presented several ideas and proposals for potentially increasing shul revenue. As a result, the Board approved an expanded Guardian program, with memberships at \$10K, \$12K and \$18K levels. Guardian members make a single pledge for the year that covers membership dues, High Holiday seats, special appeals, all fees, etc. The change to the program is not expected to make a significant near-term impact. However, it is hoped that as more of our members are economically blessed, they will consider this approach to supporting our shul.

Also approved was a special membership rate for members under thirty. (We currently have no members in that age bracket.) For those under thirty, full membership will cost only \$150 and building fund payments will be deferred. The intent is to present an attractive option to very young families, some of whom *daven* with us frequently, but have not yet joined an area shul and may still be living in apartments.

Andy also presented several possible methods to increase the financial support of other non-members who use our facility on a regular basis. The issue will be further discussed at the next Board meeting, along with his proposal that we create a more formal and active fund-raising committee. (Membership dues and High Holiday seat fees cover less than 60% of our annual budget.)

Tisha B'Av Youth Program

Over sixty of our youngsters spent a meaningful and memorable Tisha B'Av afternoon in our shul's Social Hall at a varied program planned and executed by our Youth Director Judah Rosenbaum, who was supported by his wife, Elana. Among the highlights were:

- A discussion between "Team Achdut" and "Team Shalom" about why the Beit Hamikdash was destroyed and how we have to work together as a nation and as a team to rebuild it; followed by several team building races and activities.
- Arts & crafts projects with the children creating sand art representations of the Kotel, the Beit Hamikdash, or Yerushalyim;
- An educational "Mad Science" presentation which proved to be both engaging and entertaining.

The program was also appreciated by the parents for whom the burden of entertaining their children on a long, hot fast day was somewhat mitigated.
