There is no *mitzvah* in the entire Torah that is mentioned more times than that of caring for the "stranger." 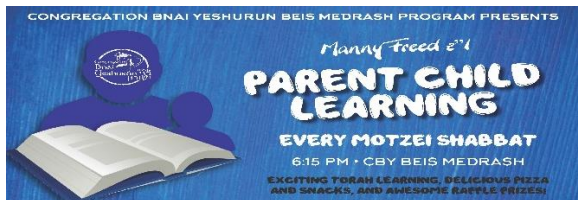
