Men's Club Preparations Underway For Simchat Torah Celebration

If you haven't personally hosted a buffet dinner for 500-1,000 of your close friends, it may be difficult to appreciate the effort involved in preparing a CBY Men's Club Kiddush (MCK). In three days, on *Simchat Torah*, you will enjoy the fruits (and the *cholent* and the *kugel*) of all that effort.

Every MCK is "launched" with a mid-week email from Men's Club



President Jonny Bendavid (*see photo*). Addressed to some forty MC members, the email generally includes top-level guidelines and instructions, e.g., *confirm order of 50 pounds of potato kugel and 70 pounds of cholent; need the following items from Restaurant Depot; shopping list for supermarket*. Within seconds, there will be "respond all" emails from members, e.g., *sorry, away for Shabbos; more chicken nuggets, kids like them; we had too much chicken Marsala last time*.

Like some regenerating organism, the plan adapts and evolves; everything quickly falls into place; and, by *Erev Shabbos* or *Erev Yom Tov*, all the warmers and chillers in the CBY kitchen are stocked with the needed delicacies.

On the day of the *Kiddush*, the specialty chefs go to work- slicing and dicing fruit (because it's cheaper than buying ready-made platters), mixing franks and beans in a ratio that is secretly passed from generation to generation, cutting gefilte fish and its concomitant carrot slice with military precision, and ensuring that the *cholent* is thoroughly mixed and has precisely the right moisture (i.e., grease) content. Perhaps, when you partake of the MCK on *Simchat Torah* you'll better appreciate the considerable efforts that went into it. And the only request from the MC Chefs is that there be some matjes herring available for a periodic snack.

And if you're still struggling with the thought of dragging yourself out of bed in time to attend the 7 am *Hashkoma Minyan* on *Simchat Torah* morning, recognize that the Men's Club *Minyan* will start at 6:30 am, so that MC members can begin early preparations for the rest of us.

For our membership, every Men's Club *Kiddush* provides an opportunity for social interaction and camaraderie and reduces the criticality of the answer to the question, "What time is lunch?" But the Men's Club, through our annual pre-Pesach Gala *Kiddush* and the other *kiddushes* throughout the year, covers nearly ten percent of the shul's annual operating expenses. In addition, the annual "IDF *Kiddush*" raises at least \$60,000 annually for Friends of the IDF and *Yashar L'Chayal*.

A standard *kiddush* sponsorship is \$99. Eight years ago, with sponsorships somewhat in decline, Fred Nagler invented *Amudei Kiddush*, a group of members who would make an annual contribution of \$360 and would be acknowledged as sponsors for
