## CBY Welcomes Israel's Chief Rabbi HaRav David Lau shlit"a

Israel's Chief Rabbi HaRav David Lau shlit"a will spend this Shabbat, Parshat Chayei Sarah, November 2-3, with Congregation Bnai Yeshurun. He will speak at a Friday night Oneg, at Shabbat morning's 9 o'clock minyan and following mincha. (Please see page 2, column 1 for details.)

When Rav Lau was appointed Chief Ashkenazai Rabbi of the State of Israel in 2013, at the age of 47, he was the youngest ever to be elected to that office. Born in Tel Aviv, Rav Lau is the son of former Chief Rabbi HaRav Yisrael Meir Lau shlit"a. Rav David Lau studied at Yeshivat Yishuv HaHadash, and later at Yeshivat Beit Matityahu and the Ponevezh Yeshiva. He was the first rabbi of the town of Shoham in the Central District of Israel. When the city of Modi'in was established, Rav Lau was chosen as its Ashkenazi Chief Rabbi alongside the Sephardi Chief Rabbi Eliyahu Alharar. Together, they established Torah classes in the city; their subjects included kashrut, eruvim, and Jewish weddings. Rabbi Lau is a reserve major in the Intelligence Corps.



Rav Lau was the first rabbi in Israel to teach responsa over the internet. Since 2006, he has appeared every Friday on the show, *Ask the Rabbi on HaArutz HaRishon*, a program which deals with a wide range of halakhic issues. Since 1999, he has broadcast the daily program *Jewish Point* on the radio station *Kol Chai*.

Having published articles in journals such as *Tehumin*, Rav Lau also edited a book of his father's responsa and he edited and published a book in memory of his grandfather, Rabbi Yitzchak Yedidya Frankel. In 2008, Rav Lau published his book, *Maskil LeDovid*, on issues of genealogy, conversion, military law, and other matters.

## CBY Executives Report Progress At Board of Directors Meeting

Progress on several fronts was reported at last week's Board of Directors Meeting. Primary focus was on matters related to the *Yomim Nora'im* and the shul's financial status.

It was reported that for the recent 5779 High Holiday services 1,691 seats were sold, 40 more than in the prior year. President Ethan Keiser thanked Sharon Kolb for chairing the Seating Committee. Gabbai Rishon Chaim Kiss explained that he was meeting with the Rabbi and *gabbaim* of all the *minyanim* to identify any perceived shortcomings. That will be followed by a corrective action plan.

There was favorable comment about *Simchat Torah* in Bnai Yeshurun overall. The Committee will still review various aspects and make recommendations to make next year even better.

Assistant Treasurer Saul Kaszovitz reviewed our financial status. Five months into the fiscal year (which starts June 1<sup>st</sup>) we are "on track" to meet the annual financial plan, currently showing a small favorable variance. In addition to the additional High Holiday seats, the proceeds of the *Kol Nidre* Appeal were somewhat higher this year. Ethan thanked the *Kol Nidrei* Appeal Chairperson Dovid Weinstein.

Executive Director Elysia Stein reported that, since the last Board meeting, six families have joined the shul as full members and six have joined as affiliates. She read several notes from the new families who appreciated the *minyanim* and other benefits they derived from CBY and joined our shul to express their appreciation.

Several changes to the committee structure were briefly discussed and unanimously approved. TORA (Teaneck Orthodox Retiree Association) will operate as a CBY Committee. The *Chevra Kadisha* Committee will be bifurcated, one arm dealing with *tahara* and matters associated with a funeral and the other arm dealing with the week of *shiva*. There will be a new Fundraising Committee to take a more holistic view and help co-ordinate our multiple fundraising efforts.
