One of the bright young stars in Jewish music, Miller is blessed with a beautiful voice and a charismatic personality. During the day, he saves lives and takes care of the sick and infirm, working as a paramedic for the Jerusalem-based nonprofit organization Magen Lacholeh and the IDF. At night, he adds *simcha* to all manner of

joyous Jewish celebrations. Miller will be accompanied by the popular Yedidim Choir. A group of talented Chassidic singers, their renditions span a wide range of musical styles and moods.

The plan, developed by our *gabbai'im* in concert with Rabbi Pruzansky, is to enhance our *tefillot*, especially *Hallel*, rather than to unnecessarily lengthen the *davening*. We hope that women who may not often come to shul and teen-agers who often do not *daven* with their parents will all join together for *tefillah* on this special *Shabbat*.

This note is to remind you of CBY's long-standing policy that "collectors," asking for money for themselves or some organization, must remain outside of our building. Unfortunately, there have been cases when collectors took clothing from our coatrooms and other objects from the shul and disturbed the tefillah in various minyanim. Just recently, collectors entered the social hall and shul during a simcha and harassed the baalei simcha and their family members. We all understand the importance of tzedaka and we empathize with the less fortunate but allowing collectors into the building can lead to serious disturbance of our shul's functioning. Please also understand that individuals intending to attack or harm our members can easily pass themselves off as "collectors" to gain access to our facility. Note that at this week's meeting of the Board of Directors, the policy was affirmed with no objection. We need your vigilance and assistance to keep our shul safe. If you see "collectors" in our facility, please ask them, respectfully but forcefully, to leave. If you are reluctant to confront the individual please inform a gabbai, officer or member of the Board who will address the situation. If a "collector" becomes hostile or threatening in any way, please call the Teaneck police. This is potentially a very serious matter and we really need everyone's cooperation and support. When you see collectors outside our building, please respect them and be generous in offering your assistance.
