## Bnai Yeshurun to Host Inspirational Lecture by Rav Moshe Weinberger

Bnai Yeshurun will host a special *shiur* by Rav Moshe Weinberger *shlita* on Tuesday, September 4<sup>th</sup>, at 8:30 pm. In anticipation of and preparation for *Rosh Hashanna* and *Yom Kippur*, Rav Weinberger will discuss *To Forgive and Be Forgiven*. The event has been organized by the Beis Medrash Committee.



Rav Weinberger has served as *Mashpia* (spiritual guide) at Yeshiva University since 2013, and is the founding *Morah d'Asrah* of Congregation Aish Kodesh in Woodmere, NY. A noted speaker, Rav Weinberger has a special ability to communicate with and inspire Jews of all backgrounds. The child of Holocaust survivors, Rav Weinberger was raised in a

modern Orthodox home in Queens. He attended Yeshiva University, planning a career in law. But he was also drawn to the world of *Chassidut*, his grandparents being Belzer *Chassidim*, and he ultimately elected to make the rabbinate and teaching Torah and *yahadut* his life work.

Holder of *semicha* from YU and Master's degrees from YU's Bernard Revel Graduate School of Jewish Studies and Columbia University's Teacher's College, Rav Weinberger has noted that many religious Jews may follow the letter of *halacha* without feeling its inner joy or a personal connection with God. He teaches and utilizes some of the tenets and practices of *Chassidut* to rekindle excitement and joy in Jewish observance.

In his *shiurim* and writings, Rav Weinberg draws on a wide swath of traditional sources. He fuses *chassidic* sources such as the Baal Shem Tov, Ramchal, Nachum of Breslov and the Baal HaTanya with the wisdom of the Vilna Gaon, Rav Tzadok HaKohen and Rabbi Abraham Isaac Kook. Rav Weinberg has recorded thousands of *shiurim*, which serve as a source of Torah learning and inspiration to men and woman across the world.
