## Department of Homeland Security Awards Special Grant to Bnai Yeshurun

Last week, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security announced that Bnai Yeshurun has been awarded a special grant, under a program designed to provide physical facility hardening measures to protect nonprofit institutions.

The \$85,000 award will pay for expansion of our newly-installed lockdown system and for other facility security enhancements. Adam Hirsch, Chair of CBY's Security Committee for the past four and a half years, thanked Executive Director Elysia Stein who led the grant application process that culminated in the award. This is the 4<sup>th</sup> and largest security grant that CBY has received over the past several years. The grant is paying for the basic lockdown system, protective barriers placed around our building's perimeter, an upgraded camera system, improved exterior lighting, and more.

You probably have noticed various elements of the lockdown system being installed over the past several months. It is now fully operational and a security drill to better acquaint the membership with the system's operation will be conducted in several weeks. If there is a dangerous situation in any of our sanctuaries, any member may activate the system by pressing one of the switches, thereby locking the doors to that *minyan* to protect *mispalilim* until the police arrive. Pressing the switch also triggers a siren throughout the building, notifying other congregants to lock down their individual *minyanim*.



This past Saturday evening, before *selichot*, our security leadership team of Adam

Hirsch, Yali Elkin, and Peter Titem (see photo) met with the entire CBY security team (see photo) to discuss preparations for the *Yomim Noraim* and to walk through a simulated lockdown drill. Our security team currently has just over 20 members, each of whom is trained by Community Security Services (CSS), a non-profit organization that has provided training for shuls across the tristate area. Special training will also be conducted for all youth leaders in the near future. The security team is always looking for more team members; interested congregants are urged to contact the shul office or any member of the security leadership team.

In addition to completing the initial phase of the lockdown system, Adam reported that additional police presence has been temporarily approved for the peak times when the shul is heavily occupied.
