Saturday Night at the Movies: Baseball, Jewish Identity, and Israeli Pride

How often can you go to an event with your kids and, afterwards, fight about who enjoyed it more? That is likely to be the case when, on **מוצאי שבת**, CBY will host an event that is expected to be a "home run" for the entire family. Sponsored jointly by the Adult Education Committee, the Teen Department, and the David Frohlich a"h Youth Department, CBY will show the movie, *Heading Home: The Tale of Team Israel* at 7:30 in our Social Hall. Refreshments will be served; there is no charge for the screening.

This uplifting, moving, intimate sports documentary tells the inspiring story of a team of nice Jewish baseball players who take on the world. Some of them are major league players who join the national team to compete. After years of defeat, Team Israel is finally ranked among the world's best in 2017, eligible to compete in the prestigious international tournament - the World Baseball Classic. The film has already won the Best Documentary award at several Jewish Film Festivals.

Attending the event Saturday evening will be Jordy Alter, Team Equipment Manager and Vice President of the Israeli Association of Baseball. He will speak about his experience as part of the Israeli Team, and also discuss plans for Israel to send a baseball team to Tokyo for the 2020 Summer Olympics. In addition, one of the three Producers/Directors will be joining us for the screening. Special thanks to Ira Jaskoll for planning and coordinating the event.

The movie records the team's travels to Israel to make a connection with the country they were to represent. They visited the *Kotel*, *Yad VaShem*, Masada, and the site of the planned baseball stadium in Beit Shemesh. All the players, most of whom had never been to Israel, were moved by their visit and it is fascinating to see them reconnect with their Jewish roots.

Despite the rainy weather, over 100 people came to CBY on Monday evening to listen to Jonathan Medved, founder and CEO of OurCrowd, the world's largest equity crowdfunding and venture capital platform. His subject was *Turning Curses into Blessings: How Israeli Startups are Meeting Global Challenges*. Medved's presentation described the extent to which Israeli startups are contributing to advances in technology and to the creation of wealth. By both measures Israel's contributions are many times more than would be expected from a country with such a small population.
