Moshe endured transfers to six different camps and was eventually liberated at Buchenwald on April 11, 1945. Traveling illegally to Palestine, he joined the Haganah, and fought in the wars from 1947 to 1950 and in 1956. Moshe came to the U. S. to pursue his studies.
