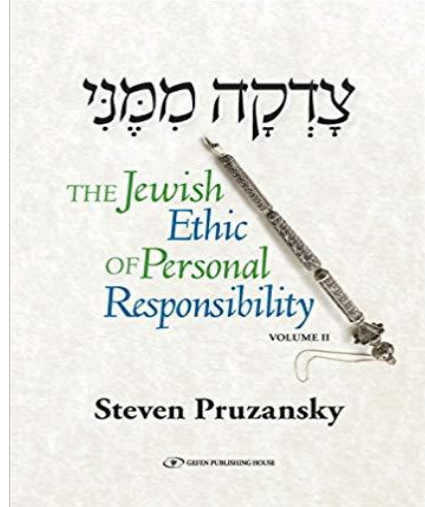

Rabbi Pruzansky Publishes Second Volume On Personal Responsibility

Those who have listened to the *derashot* of Rabbi Pruzansky or read his writings know that a recurring theme is that of personal responsibility. Basic to the concept of free choice and our acceptance of the teachings of the Torah is the recognition that we must accept responsibility for our actions- in every aspect of our lives. Gefen Publishing has just released the Rabbi's 2nd volume of *צדקה ממני* *The Jewish Ethic of Personal Responsibility*.



As in Volume I, the Rabbi's approach is to pay careful attention to the behavior of personalities and events that HaShem has chosen to include in the Torah and to draw lessons to inform our behavior and find role models to emulate. The newly-released volume draws its lessons from the books of Vayikra, Bamidbar and Devarim. The format of the book makes it very readable, each weekly parsha being a stand-alone entity that is easily

absorbed. And each lesson is more likely to be remembered and make a lasting impression because each is linked to a specific event and personality.

Business dealings, family relationships, observance of the mitzvot, dating, marriage, military service, gainful employment- every aspect of daily life brings with it responsibilities and obligations and the Rabbi presents the parameters as deduced from our understanding of the Torah.

Both volumes could provide a structured approach to reviewing the *sedra* and to stimulating discussion around the *Shabbat* table. One of our responsibilities is to foster development of this broad sense of personal responsibility in our children. But parent-child conversations that begin with "You must" or even "You should" are likely to get pedantic and even confrontational. On the other hand, if the conversation begins with *parashat hashavua* and starts analyzing the responsibilities and obligations of others,
