Rabbi Zahtz Addresses Membership To Share His Personal Aspirations

The Talmud (*Zevachim* 71b) tells us that there is no joy, there is no contentment, like the joy of resolving and removing doubts. Rabbi Ari Zahtz used this teaching to characterize his feelings to a standing-room-only audience in shul this past Shabbat morning. Speaking at the request of the Board of Directors, R' Zahtz explained his decision (conveyed to the Board several days earlier) to withdraw himself from consideration to be CBY's next *Mara D'atra*.



Drawing on role models like Yehoshua and Yosef, R' Zahtz explained the importance of taking a longer-range view of matters and not just "living in the moment." He went on to candidly discuss his thoughts in the weeks since R' Pruzansky announced that he and his family would be making *Aliyah* in the summer of 2020, about the same time as R' Zahtz's contract with Bnai Yeshurun would expire.

R' Zahtz described a "roller coaster of emotions" as he and his family considered his options and long-range career plans. "I did not end up at the place that I thought I would when I started this process." Relating that he felt blessed by HaShem, with an amazing wife and children and with incredible career opportunities, R' Zahtz recounted that when he was sitting in his classes, studying for *semicha*, he could never have imagined that a few years down the road he would be on the rabbinical team of one of the world's premier shuls and a Ra"m at RIETS, teaching Torah at the highest level and guiding *talmidim* in the warmth of YU's Beis Medrash. Furthermore, he added, these roles really complement and strengthen each other. The thought of losing one or the other of these roles has been "gnawing." Ultimately, he explained, he decided that he is not ready to choose between them and, as a result, was withdrawing from any current consideration to serve as our *Mara D'Attra*.

R' Zahtz went on to explain that of the various options he had considered, his final choice would not only be best for him, but best for Bnai Yeshurun. He pointed out that he did not want to take any action that could lead to "discord or fragmentation" of our *kehillah*. His choice is to continue in his current role, to expand certain aspects, and to provide continuity and stability moving forward. "Bnai Yeshurun could be at the start of something very exciting and energetic," concluded R' Zahtz. Following his talk, congregants streamed toward the pulpit to thank R' Zahtz for his inspiring message and for his leadership at a critical point in the evolution of Congregation Bnai Yeshurun.

Board of Directors Begins To Address Rabbinical Succession

You might think, given Rabbi Pruzansky's January announcement that he and his family are planning *Aliyah* in July 2020, that our Board of Directors has started assembling a first-class rabbinical search committee. They have not and for good reasons. Instead, our lay leadership has embarked on a thoughtful and comprehensive process intended to usher in a new and exciting period in the evolution and growth of our *kehillah*.

Shortly after R' Pruzansky's announcement, the Executive Committee began working closely with Rabbi Ronald Schwarzberg, Director of Jewish Career Guidance and Placement at YU's Center for the Jewish Future. In that role for 14 years, R' Schwarzberg has placed hundreds of RIETS and RCA rabbis in their positions. After consulting with other shul's that have worked with R' Schwarzberg and his team, the Committee invited R' Schwarzberg to the February Board meeting.

That meeting began with Rabbi Zahtz explaining his desire to continue to be part of the CBY rabbinical team, in a role similar to the one he currently holds. When R' Zahtz left the meeting the Board unanimously approved a resolution to thank R' Zahtz for his inspiring talk and suggested that he share his thoughts with the entire membership.

R' Schwarzberg was then introduced and he began by lauding R' Zahtz's talk for its "incredible clarity" and his decision that created a wonderful "opportunity for Bnai Yeshurun." He went on to explain the critical need for a "transition period," before we embark on a rabbinical search. R' Schwarzberg explained that many feel close personal ties to R' Pruzansky who celebrated with them at their family *smachot* and comforted them in their moments of sorrow. After such a long tenure, he said, we need a closure process for these strong ties and relationships.

R' Schwarzberg described additional things that must be done *before* we consider rabbinical candidates or even create a job description. We first need to step back and think about what we want for Bnai Yeshurun three or five or ten years down the road. What kind of community do we want to be? What sort of rabbinic leadership do we really want? We need a process that involves every single member and captures the vision of the overwhelming majority of our congregants. The process must be transparent so that everyone recognizes that, while they may not ultimately agree with every aspect of every decision, Bnai Yeshurun is being moved by the collective will of its membership. R' Schwarzberg described CJF Consult, a process wherein he and

his staff help congregations assess and articulate their needs before looking for a new rabbi. The process includes structured focus meetings (both on weekday evenings and on Sundays) that bring to the surface the full range of membership opinion in a thorough and fair-minded way.

The output of the focus groups is the basis for a confidential on-line survey of the entire membership. The survey results are shared with the membership and serve as the basis for the job description for our *Mora D'Atra*. Then and only then, said R' Schwarzberg, can a Search Committee begin to identify and screen candidates. The process will culminate in the entire membership getting the opportunity to meet candidates and vote for our next *Mora D'Atra*. (Our constitution requires approval by at least 55% of those voting.)

After R' Schwarzberg's presentation and a follow up Q&A session, a resolution was unanimously approved to appoint a committee to begin negotiations on a new contract for R' Zahtz. (That contract will also have to be approved by the entire membership.) R' Zahtz has requested, given his decision, that his on-going role and relationship with Bnai Yeshurun be clarified. R' Schwarzberg strongly endorsed the resolution, explaining that a new contract with R' Zahtz would make it easier to recruit a new *Mora D'Atra* and would provide continuity in our shul's rabbinic leadership.

The Board also unanimously approved a resolution to retain the professional and independent CJF Consult services throughout the transition and search process. R' Schwarzberg characterized Bnai Yeshurun as an outstanding opportunity and expects we will have exceptional candidates from which to select. He believes we should look forward to an exciting period for Bnai Yeshurun.
