Rabbi Ezra Stone Leads Davening Focused on Pre-Teen Members

Bnai Yeshurun members no longer pay much attention when we add yet another *minyan* to our (*Boruch HaShem*) numerous weekday or *Shabbat* options for *tefilla b'tsibbur*. But the recent creation of a *Shabbat* morning Junior *minyan* for our 5th and 6th graders is closing a significant gap and is proving to be a popular addition. Designed to instill a better understanding and appreciation for *davening* in our 5th and 6th graders and to serve as a transition to our regular Teen *Minyan*, the Junior Congregation is led by Rabbi Ezra Stone.



Currently finishing his *semicha* studies at Yeshiva University and a member of the Katz Kollel, Rabbi Stone is also completing his master's degree in Jewish Education at YU's Azrieli Graduate School. He is also Assistant Student Activities Director at TABC. At CBY he is developing meaningful relationships with many of our pre-teens and imparting an understanding of the importance of *tefilla*.

The new Junior Congregation, typically attended by 30-40 of our boys and girls, meets on our social hall stage at 9:25 am. *Davening* is followed by an inspiring *dvar Torah*, often delivered by dynamic youth leader D J Wartelsky, or an informative skit based on the *parsha*.

Lord our God, make the teachings of Your Torah pleasant on our lips and on the lips of Your people, the house of Israel. With this simple prayer with which we start every day, Rabbi "Itzy" Weinberger sought to epitomize his father, HaRav Shlomo Weinberger, who was *niftar* this past Monday.



Rav Weinberger's passing was a tremendous loss not only for his family but for the Torah world and, in a very deep way, for Bnai Yeshurun and the Teaneck community. After serving as a pulpit Rabbi for over forty years and being responsible in no small measure for the creation of a thriving Orthodox community in Passaic, Rav Weinberger "retired" and came to live in Teaneck. For the past fifteen years, he has had a profound and personal influence on so many of us and has been a source of guidance and wisdom—a precious community asset.

Every day of the week, for fifteen years, he studied Torah with us, elevating the quality of our *Daf Yomi* learning and giving us *chizuk* in *chavurahs* and *shiurim*. He had neither patience or pretense nor sufferance for superficiality. In learning *Gemara*, he demanded accuracy, clarity and rigor. "Don't tell me 'Tosfot disagrees.' Tell me precisely how he disagrees and, hopefully, why he disagrees." And at the

same time Rav Weinberger was a paradigm of אהבת ישראל, of not only "accepting" all Jews regardless of their religiosity or knowledge of Torah, but of loving and respecting them. He was a *yashar* in every aspect of his life.

Above all, Rav Weinberger was the ultimate *masmid*, always excited to learn, always enthused to teach, always exuding the sweetness of תלמוד תורה.

At the conclusion of the Junior Congregation, there is an optional learning program, called the *Shabbat Learning Incentive Program*, or SLIP, where our 5th & 6th graders learn *hilchot tefilla* and develop better insights into their *davening*. (The members who attend SLIP regularly plan to attend a sporting event together in the spring.)

The youngsters can also participate in a variety of games or just "hang out" with their friends in a welcoming and supervised environment. All that is followed by a themed kiddush designed around food treats that appeal to the kids.
