Rabbi Dr. Ari Berman Analyzes Teshuva Concepts

Rabbi Dr. Ari Berman delivered the 35th Annual Hausman/Stern *Kinus Teshuva* Lecture on Sunday evening, October 6th. Speaking in our New Main Shul, Rabbi Berman, the president of Yeshiva University, spoke on *Living Mindfully and Meaningfully: The Teshuva of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur*.



The *Teshuva* of *Yom Kippur*, explained Rabbi Berman, is the antidote to sin. It is focused on what we've done in the past. We identify and confess sins that we've already committed. Basing his talk on the writings of the Rambam and Gaonic scholars, Rabbi Berman described a *Teshuva* of *Rosh Hashanah*, intended to counter, not sin, but *hevel-* folly, mindless behavior, wasted opportunity. It is a *Teshuva* focused on the future. It is a *Teshuva*, not so much for sinners as it is for "sleepers."

When the Rambam famously explains that the purpose of sounding the *Shofar* is to wake those who are slumbering, Rabbi Berman explains that the reference is to those who live in a mindless fashion, failing to actualize their potentiality. He went on to demonstrate that the *mitzvah* of *mezuzah* is to constantly remind us of the need for mindfulness and intentionality. Every time we pass through a door, we need to be aware; every entry is an exit and every exit is an entry; at every step we make choices, choices with potentially eternal consequences. We need to continuously ask ourselves, "Am I on the right path? Is this the life that *Hashem* wants for me?"

Dr. Berman described individuals, very successful in their professions and beyond financially secure, who, nevertheless, are so busy and so consumed by their jobs that they never get to do the things that they really want to do and the things that would bring a better life to them and to those around them.

Citing a Talmudic teaching of Rabbi Yochanan that *Teshuva* can extend one's years, Rabbi Berman noted that we sometimes see counter-examples, individuals who do *teshuva* but die at a young age. He suggested that Rabbi Yochanan's message is that *teshuva*, the *teshuva* to lead a mindful and intentional life, will extend the significance of one's year's making life more meaningful and memorable. In keeping with his theme, Dr. Berman concluded by wishing his large audience a "year of consciousness and intentionality."

The Hausman-Stern lecture series was established by the late philanthropists Judy and Gerson Hausman, supporters of YU and RIETS, to honor the memory of their parents. This year it was additionally co-sponsored by CBY's Adult Education Committee.
