Daf Yomi Participants Prepare For Next Week's Ta'anit Bechorim

While some of our traditional sources disagree as to the origin of and reason for תענית בכורים, the pre-Pesach Fast of the First Born that occurs next Friday, it is universally accepted that virtually no one actually fasts on that fast day. Rather, those obligated to fast attend a *siyum* and accompanying *se'udah* that has been conveniently scheduled to coincide with *erev Pesach*. This year, there will be no shortage of those able to "make a *siyum*," as approximately forty of your fellow *mispalilim* who participate in *Daf Yomi* study, conclude their study of the tractate of *Chulin* this Thursday (or wait until Friday to avoid the fast).

Those who participate in *Daf Yomi* are constantly fascinated by the never-ending "coincidences" they encounter, e.g., the *daf* of the day citing a verse from the portion of the Torah that we read that day. Is it just a "coincidence" that on Friday's תענית בכורים we are scheduled to begin the study of מסכת בכורות? What are the chances? (2,711 to one)

The novel idea that Jews in all parts of the world should study the same *daf* each day, with the goal of completing the entire Talmud in 7 1/2 years (2,711 days), was proposed by Rabbi Meir Shapiro, zt"l, future *rosh yeshiva* of Yeshivas Chachmei Lublin, at the First World Congress of Agudath Israel, which took place in Vienna in 1923. The first cycle of *Daf Yomi* began on the first day of Rosh Hashanah 5684 (11 September 1923), with tens of thousands of Jews in Europe, America and Israel participating.

On the 9th of Kislev 5743- November 25th, Thanksgiving Day in 1982- Rabbi Yossie Stern a"h convinced a few CBY *ba'alei bittim* to "get with the program" and they began studying ברכות, the beginning of the 9th *Daf Yomi* cycle. (Thanksgiving Day? Just a coincidence?) That small group included Alan Schoffman and Marvin Oppenheim, both of whom, almost 38 years later, are still "regulars" at the 5:30 am *Daf*.

Special thanks to CBY's current *maggidei* shiur: Manny Adler, Manny Adler, Kenny Bander, Ira Cooper, Moishe Grinfeld, Alex Gutman, Irv Klavan, Alan Krantz, Marvin Oppenheim, Tully Polak, Aaron Rothstein, Yitz Schulman, Jackie Stromer, Rabbi Zahtz, David Zomick. (That was not a mistake. Manny gets double recognition because he teaches the *Daf* twice on every Shabbat. When he is away, Elliot Small is his designated understudy.) Thanks also to Alan Schoffman who schedules the morning *Daf* sessions and arranges for "substitute teachers" when necessary.
