CBY Board Enters New Fiscal Year Committed and Optimistic

With the June 1st start of Bnai Yeshurun's fiscal year, a sampling of Bnai Yeshurun's elected lay leadership reveals a renewed sense of commitment and optimism. President Ethan Keiser notes, "Obviously, first and foremost in all our minds is the selection of and transition to a new **מרא דאתרא**. But the Executive Committee is committed to continuous improvement in many different areas."

When the Board meets this month, it will welcome twelve recently elected directors (asterisk indicates re-elected members): Ronnie Aranoff, Shira Ashendorf, Mayer Fertig*, Ari Ganchrow*, Michelle Gellman*, Adam Pfefer*, Mike Roth, Ross Rothenberg, Yael Sebbag, Aaron Shlagbaum*, Ari Wartelsky*, Dovid Weinstein. New Board members often bring fresh perspectives and new energy to Bnai Yeshurun.

Keiser emphasizes how much he relies on the Executive Committee and how each and every officer has assumed a proactive leadership role for a core CBY process. Treasurer Andy Berkowitz is "not just keeping the books." He is seeking creative ways to raise funds from non-members and to contain costs. Vice presidents Steven Becker, Doron Katz and Jennifer Miller have "latched on" to the Beis Medrash Program, youth activities and capital improvements and facility enhancements, respectively.

Doron notes, "Looking back on this past year, I can't help but feel real satisfaction from what we've been able to do- refurbishing our classrooms, training and upgrading our youth leaders, adding new programs like "Mommy and Me," establishing a new, successful youth *minyan* led by Rabbi Stone. Item One on this year's agenda is now hiring a new youth director. We wish Judah Rosenbaum great success in his new role at TABC."

Gabbai Rishon Chaim Kiss plans to continue his concerted effort to enhance our **תפילות** and the **רוח** in our shul. He is particularly pleased that the congregation has reacted so favorably to periodically engaging guest **בעלי תפילה** and that the membership voted last week to add a talented and experienced **בעל תפילה** for the upcoming High Holidays.

Secretary Esti Kaminetzky is chairing our Rabbinic Transition team. "The focus groups went rather well" she reports, "though it's always a bit frustrating when many members simply opt out when given the opportunity to help shape the direction of the shul. We hope to find ways to incorporate everyone's voice as we make an extremely important decision about a new *rav* for Bnai Yeshurun." Saul Kaszovitz continues to play a key leadership role, focusing on "all things legal" and, in the words of a fellow board member, "always keeping us on track with his careful and methodical approach to every issue we face."
