Bnai Yeshurun Delegation to Attend Annual AIPAC Conference

Over twenty-five Bnai Yeshurun members have already registered for this year's Policy Conference of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC) which will be held Sunday, March 24th thru Tuesday, March 26th at the Walter E. Washington Convention Center in Washington, D.C. Last year, 33 of our members attended the annual event. Logan Tessler, AIPAC's Associate Director in New Jersey, hopes and expects that we will exceed that number this year.

AIPAC is a bi-partisan organization whose mission is to strengthen, protect and promote the U.S.-Israel relationship in ways that enhance the security of the United States and Israel. It advocates pro-Israel policies to Congress and the Executive Branch.

With over 18,000 attendees, the AIPAC Policy Conference is the largest gathering of America's pro-Israel community. In addition to providing every attendee the mechanism to lobby their Congressional office to advance the U.S.-Israel relationship, the Policy Conference is also a rich educational opportunity and an inspirational experience. Attendees will hear keynote speeches by American and Israeli leaders, attend intimate educational sessions, and will be inspired by moving stories of U.S.-Israel partnerships, Israeli heroism, and groundbreaking Israeli innovations that are changing our world.

At this year's conference there will be a special breakout session dedicated to Teaneck congregations, in an attempt to create "a community within a community" according to Tessler.
