## Manny Freed z"l Parent Child Learning Seeks Wider Participation & Support

Speaking to the well-over 200 participants in Saturday evening's Manny Freed z"l Parent Child Learning (MFPCL), Rabbi Zahtz explained, "It's so beautiful. You are making *Shabbat* longer. You are turning Saturday night into שבת מוצאי שבת."



November 9, 2019. One hour after Shabbat

It's about a dozen years since the Parent-Child Learning Program began and over six years since the Weinberger family dedicated the program in memory of Manny Freed z"l, father of Mona Weinberger. Winter, spring, summer, fall- year in and year out, each week between 100 and 150 of our youngsters flock to our Beis Medrash to study with parents and grandparents, to participate in an exciting raffle with multiple prizes and to enjoy their favorite snacks. If you have never attended, plan to visit next week. Preferably, bring a child or grandchild. If not, just come alone to see *Ma'ariv* in action, to observe the formation and forging of new links in the שלשלת, in the generation-to-generation chain that is the existential enabler of Jewish continuity and vibrancy. With our clocks changing to Standard Time, the MFPCL returns to its post-*Shabbat* time slot, about one hour after *Ma'ariv*. As we start a new season, the hope is that even more families will attend and use the opportunity to help establish *Talmud Torah* as a natural and comfortable dialog between parents and their children.

To date, financial support of MFCPL has come from only a handful of families. But the program should really be seen as a critical shul-wide endeavor. The children are the future of our shul and of the Jewish community. The program is a significant factor in attracting new, young families to Bnai Yeshurun. This year the shul has established a more structured sponsorship program, with sponsorship categories ranging from \$100 to \$5,400. ### CBY Hosts Rabbi Shaya Karlinsky; Noted Educator Will Speak Four Times

This Shabbat CBY's Adult Education committee and Shapell's/Darche Noam bring Rabbi Shaya Karlinsky to Bnai Yeshurun. The co-founder and Dean of Shapell's/Darche Noam and Midreshet Rachel in Jerusalem, Rabbi Karlinsky will speak at an *Oneg Shabbat* this evening, at both the 8:30 and 9:00 o'clock *minyanim* tomorrow and following the 4:15 *mincha*.



A Los Angeles native, Rabbi Karlinsky went to Israel in 1968, learning in Yeshivat Kerem B'Yavneh and the Mir Yeshiva, Jerusalem. He received *smicha* from the ITRI Kollel. After completing a MEd in Educational Psychology at Temple University, he settled in Israel, teaching at the original Shapell College, BMT, and Aish HaTorah. Rabbi Karlinsky is also an accomplished photojournalist whose work has been published in Time, Newsweek, and the New York Times and exhibited at the Israel Museum. Rabbi Karlinsky and his wife Ruthie, live in Har Nof, Jerusalem.
