CBY Welcomes New Youth Directors Rivka and Yehoshua Szafranski

Come August 25th, Bnai Yeshurun's youth programming will not miss a step, but it will be marching to the beat of different drummers. On that day, the David Frohlich z"l Youth Department welcomes its new directors, Rivka and Yehoshua Szafranski.

Several months ago, Judah Rosenbaum, after nine years as our youth director, informed the shul that he would be leaving to become the executive director of TABC. Our youth program was expanded and enhanced during his tenure and we wish him continued success in his new role. We are very pleased that he and his wife Elana have chosen to stay with CBY as members. After an extensive search by our shul's youth committee, the Board of Directors approved the hiring of the Szafranskis at its July meeting.

Doron Katz, who, with Sari Sheinfeld, co-chaired the search team, expressed his excitement about the new directors. "We interviewed a number of qualified candidates," he said, "but Yehoshua and Rivka stood out as a really special team. Their intelligence, motivation, and thoughtful approach to youth programming will ensure the continued growth and improvement of all aspects of our youth activities."

Our new youth directors described their two over-arching objectives. First and foremost, they want each child to be "comfortable" at Bnai Yeshurun. Each child is unique, with his or her needs and personality and interests, but each must feel they have a "place" where they are welcome and in which they feel comfortable. Second, they want our children to feel excited that they are part of a larger community and they should want to come to shul to be part of that larger community.

Explaining their approach to achieving their objectives, the Szafranskis focused on two key enablers. They talked about "intentionality," careful and thoughtful planning as to the best way to meet specific objectives. And that intentionality helps to shape every youth event and program. They also stressed the importance of investing in our youth leaders, who they will call 'youth educators,' and who may very well be the next generation of leaders of כלל ישראל. We need them to be motivated and enthusiastic and we have to help them develop into the best that they can be. They have to feel valued and trusted and we will encourage their creativity in planning and executing our various programs.

Yehoshua, a student in YU's *semicha* program, has been serving as the director of NCSY's Leadership Experience and Development (LEAD) Program. The son of long-time CBY affiliate members Sherri and Chaim Szafranski, Yehoshua has been a Fellow in the Memphis Torah Leadership program, planning and developing educational programs for all ages and across the religious spectrum of the Memphis Jewish community. He has also held responsible positions in summer camps including director of aquatics and division head.

A Cum Laude graduate of Stern College, Rivka majored in psychology and minored in business management. She also served as an NCSY LEAD Director. She has been the host of a radio show, "Teen Spirit," and has lectured extensively about Israel advocacy, Israeli history, and politics in New York, New Jersey, Washington, Canada, and Israel. Most recently, she has been a campaign executive for Aish HaTorah, organizing and managing fund-raising initiatives. She has also served as director of Manhattan NCSY, developing and implementing educational and experiential programs for diverse Manhattan teenagers.

In addition to Doron Katz and Sari Sheinfeld, special thanks go to Steven Becker, Naomi Davidson, Ethan Keiser, Henry Orlinsky, and Chaya Schwartz for their youth program efforts. A schedule will be released shortly for youth events over the next three months and our Youth Committee is planning to send you a brief video in which our new directors can introduce themselves and share their vision and plans. This past week the Szafranskis moved from their Washington Heights residence to the West Englewood home that had been occupied by the Rosenbaums. Please welcome them into our community.
