## Teaneck Teens to Join With CBY In Yahrzeit Tribute to Rabbi Dovid Kaminetsky, z"l

All of the local *Shabbat* morning Teaneck-Bergenfield Teen *minyanim*, will join together at Bnai Yeshurun in a united *achdut minyan*, to mark the first *yahrzeit* of R' Dovid Kaminetsky, z"l. To be held in two weeks, פרשת בחוקותי, (June 1<sup>st</sup>) at 9 am in our Social Hall, the teen *minyanim* of Beth Abraham, Keter Torah, Rinat Yisrael, Beth Abraham and Ohr Hatorah will be *davening* with us to honor Rabbi Kaminetsky's legacy. Rabbi Kaminetsky's sons, R' Yisroel and Daniel, will deliver the *derasha* that morning and lead the *Tefila*. They will be joined by Mrs. Sury Kaminetsky & Mrs. Lisa Kaminetsky Zakutinsky.



Rabbi Kaminetsky founded the community's first teen *minyan* in Bnai Yeshurun. With his unique dignity and grace, he led the *minyan* for over twenty years, inspiring many other shuls to follow his model and establish their own teen *minyanim*. He taught the teens to become *shlichei tzibbur* and *baalei keriah*, and delivered weekly *divrei Torah* that were specifically crafted to reach his young audience.

Rabbi Kaminetsky also held important positions in the world of Jewish education – principal of Manhattan Day School, principal of Moriah in Englewood, middle school principal at Rosenbaum Yeshiva of North Jersey, and national director of NCSY.

The tribute to Rabbi Kaminetsky's legacy is being planned and organized by Rabbi Jonathan Schachter, head of our teen department. Plans leading to the special memorial tribute include a learning initiative to study the entire *Chumash* with Rashi by the teens and alumni of the *minyan*. All members of the community are welcome to participate by studying the *parsha* of their choice.
