HaRav Asher Weiss שליט"א Speaks to CBY Summer Kollel

We are in the middle of the "Three Weeks," mourning for a house that was destroyed two thousand years ago. We never saw the house and neither did our parents or grandparents. Yet, millennia after its destruction we still mourn, explained HaRav Asher Weiss, speaking in our *Beis Medrash* last Thursday. As Jews, we mourn because we don't just live in the present but we have a glorious past and a glorious and hopeful future. And then Rav Weiss launched into an illuminating analysis of the core nature of our fast days.



Dayan HaRav Asher Weiss, the author of the *Minchas Asher*, an *Av Beis Din*, *Rosh Kollel*, and *posek* visited the Summer *Kollel* at Congregation Bnai Yeshurun on the morning of July 25th. Members of the *Kollel* as well as many community *rabbanim* and *baalei battim* filled our *Beis Medrash* to listen to Rav Weiss' analysis and words of *chizzuk*.

Rav Weiss discussed the underlying nature of 28 different fast days, some of which we no longer observe. Citing numerous Talmudic sources, he separated the fasts into four categories: repentance, winning favor with *HaShem*, mourning, and remembrance. He explained the importance of *minhagim* in understanding our current practice, using as an example *Ta'anit Esther* and *Ta'anit Bechorim*, both of which fall into the remembrance category. He noted that it's not particularly clear what specifically we are supposed to remember on *Ta'anit Esther* and it's not particularly clear why we no longer fast on *Ta'anit Bechorim*. But that is the way our *minhagim* have evolved.

Rav Weiss concluded with expressions of admiration and affection for Bnai Yeshurun and the Teaneck community, citing the Summer *Kollel* as well as the large turnout of *ba'alei battim* for a *shiur* on a weekday morning.
