## **Beis Medrash Legal Holiday Shiurim; Recharge on Your Days Off**

The CBY Beis Medrash Committee plans to recharge your days off from work or school with a boost of Torah from a trifecta of leading Torah luminaries. On December 25<sup>th</sup> and January 1<sup>st</sup>, following the 8:00 am *shacharit minyan*, all are welcome to the CBY Social Hall for a light breakfast and inspirational *divrei Torah* from Rabbi Daniel Stein and Rabbi Aryeh Lebowitz, respectively.

The series began on Thanksgiving morning when Rabbi Shay Schachter packed the house, speaking about "Appreciating the Simple Jew." Rabbi Schachter received his Rabbinic ordination from both his illustrious father, Rabbi Hershel Schachter at RIETS, and from his Rebbe, Rabbi Asher Weiss of Jerusalem. He holds an MA in Jewish Education and Administration from the Azrieli Graduate School of Jewish Education. He formerly served as the Assistant Rabbi at "The White Shul" in Far Rockaway, and now serves as Rabbi and Rosh Beis Midrash at the Young Israel of Woodmere.

On Wednesday, December 25<sup>th</sup>, enhance your Chanukah morning with Rabbi Daniel Stein as he speaks about "The Parameters of *Chukat Hagoyim*." Rabbi Stein is a Rosh Yeshiva and Director of the Norman & Johanne Sternthal 4th Year Halacha Lemaaseh Program at RIETS where he holds the Perez & Frieda Friedberg Chair in Talmud. Rabbi Stein is also the Rav of The Ridniker Shteibel, Cong. Ahavath Chesed of Manhattan, and was the founding Rav of Kehillas Beis Sholom in Clifton. In addition, Rabbi Stein is an expert in the laws of *eruv* and has been consulted regarding the creation, extension, and maintenance of numerous *eruv* in the United States and Australia. This *shiur* is co-sponsored by Rena and Douglas Soclof in honor of Rav Stein and all he does for his *talmidim*.

Closing out the series will be Rabbi Aryeh Lebowitz on January 1<sup>st</sup>, who will speak on the topic of "Priorities in *Limud HaTorah* – Is it Better to Learn *B'Iyun*, Slower or to Do *Daf Yomi*." Rabbi Lebowitz is the director of Semikhah at RIETS as well as the *Mara D'atra* of Beis Haknesses of North Woodmere. He was previously a rebbe at Lander's College for Men and an eleventh grade Rebbe at the DRS Yeshiva High School. Rabbi Lebowitz has published numerous articles on practical halachic topics in various journals, including several recent articles in the Journal of Halacha and Contemporary Society. Prior to founding the Beis Haknesses of North Woodmere, Rabbi Lebowitz spent three years at Congregation Sha'aray Tefillah in Lawrence, as Assistant Rabbi as well as the Rosh Kollel of the morning Kollel.
