The Rabbi then took the opportunity to urge the youngsters to recognize the responsibilities that come with becoming a bar mitzvah. Using the weekly sedrah's discussion of the obligations and restrictions of a גייר as a springboard, the Rabbi urged his young audience to be more sensitive to "context"- to recognizing that actions may be permitted or forbidden depending on who performs them and when they are performed. The Rabbi then segued to the proper behavior and activity on Shabbos. He clearly but gently suggested that basketball was not an appropriate Shabbos afternoon activity. "We dress differently on Shabbos; we sing zmiros." The Rabbi surprised the young men when he suggested that, on Shabbos, they should "Chase girls." "Don't harass them. Don't bother them. But you're coming of age. Be friendly with them." Finally, the Rabbi suggested, "On Shabbos, talk out ideas with your friends- what it means to be a Jew." Following the Rabbi's talk, the young men devoured a large number of doughnuts and, as the sun started to go down, returned to the basketball court.
