Dr. David Berger Explores Jewish-Christian Relations

As Jews living in a country whose citizenry is overwhelmingly Christian (just over 70%), it is appropriate to periodically consider the state of Jewish-Christian relations. Often our impressions may be shaped by limited anecdotal information or the latest news cycle. Tomorrow evening, February 23rd, you have the opportunity to get a broad, thoughtful, contemporary look at this critical issue.

At 8:45 pm in our Social Hall, our Adult Ed Committee has arranged for Dr. David Berger to speak on *Jewish-Christian Relations from the Second Vatican Council to Pope Francis*. Teaneck resident and CBY affiliate member, Berger is known to many of us for his erudition and candor. He is currently the Ruth and I. Lewis Gordon Professor of Jewish History and Dean at the Bernard Revel Graduate School of Yeshiva University. Dr. Berger has been a Visiting Scholar at the Institute for Advanced Studies in Jerusalem, and a Visiting Professor at Yale and Harvard Universities. He has written numerous articles on medieval Jewish history, Jewish-Christian relations, antisemitism, contemporary Judaism, and the intellectual history of the Jews. Dr. Berger has his Ordination from Yeshiva University and his PhD from Columbia University.

Metiv's Founding Director To Speak at Bnai Yeshurun

On Monday, March 4th, Dr. Danny Brom, founding director of Metiv will visit Bnai Yeshurun to discuss *Lessons from Israel: Veteran Care, Community Preparedness and Resilience*.



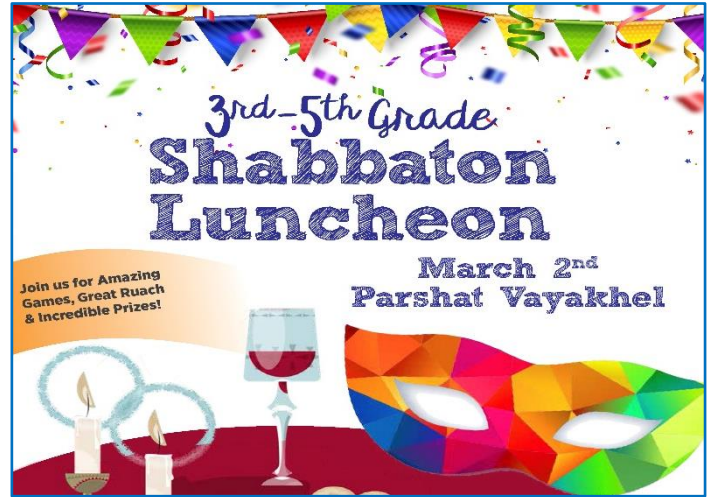
Dr. Danny Brom

Hate crimes and terrorism target not just the immediate and obvious victims, but also communities, creating widespread fear. Unfortunately, it appears that terrorism is here to stay and communities need to find ways to increase their resilience. Similarly, after Israeli youngsters join the IDF and are deployed to defend our country, they may need professionals to help them unload their psychological burden when they return from combat. Based on lessons learned coping with war and terrorism in Israel, Dr. Brom will discuss:

- The nature of community resilience, how we can increase the resilience for children and parents, and how society can organize itself in the face of ongoing threat.
- How can we take care of our veterans' well-being in a comprehensive way, not leaving in distress those who have risked their lives to protect us.

Metiv's mission is to provide clinical and other interventions that heal and empower those exposed to traumatic life experiences and to increase the recognition and the treatment implications of psychological trauma. Metiv was founded in 1989 by Dr. Brom, a Dutch-born psychologist. Israel's painful history has made its people, especially its children, particularly vulnerable to the multiple dimensions of psychological trauma. Metiv therefore focuses on a wide spectrum of trauma, ranging from terrorist attacks to bereavement to violence of all kinds, including partner violence.

Creating a network of over 2,000 professionals, with an emphasis on underserved populations, Metiv is ready to help trauma victims overcome their painful experiences. Metiv has further developed a reputation for responding to both natural and man-made disasters worldwide, training first responders and mental health professionals in Turkey, Haiti, Chechnya, Mississippi, Sri Lanka, Mexico, Nepal, and post-9/11 New York City.
