## Annual Gala Kiddush Luncheon To Celebrate Tenth Anniversary

What consumes 320 pounds of cholent in a single sitting, pays for nearly ten percent of the shul's annual budget and is celebrating its tenth birthday? The Bnai Yeshurun Annual Gala Kiddush Luncheon and it's just around the corner.

It was 2010 and Shimmy Tennenbaum was our president. The unemployment rate was 9.6%. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was hovering around 10,000. There was widespread pessimism about the future of the economy. In that environment, the CBY Executive Committee was leery about planning a regular shul dinner. Elliot Small suggested that we might, instead, have a community pre-Pesach luncheon. And that was the birth of our Annual Gala Kiddush Luncheon and the origin of the oft-quoted phrase "one Small step for mankind."

The luncheon was an immediate success and not only for its ability to raise much-needed funds. It was an opportunity for Bnai Yeshurun families to dine together- to develop new relationships and re-energize old ones. It made preparing for Pesach just a bit easier. Under the leadership of Jonny Bendavid and Rhonda Avner, the annual luncheons have grown in size and become a strong Bnai Yeshurun tradition.

This year's luncheon will be on *Shabbat HaGadol*, April 13<sup>th</sup>, which is ideal in terms of facilitating Pesach preparation. Last year 350 Bnai Yeshurun families came together for lunch and we hope that this year's participation will be even greater.

Obviously, it takes significant effort to prepare

lunch for well over 1,000 people. Here's how you can help:

- First and foremost, please plan to join us; RSVP at your earliest convenience.
- Recognize that the luncheon is one of our largest fund-raising opportunities. Please be generous in your response. Even if you can't attend and have not donated in the past, show your solidarity by participating this year.

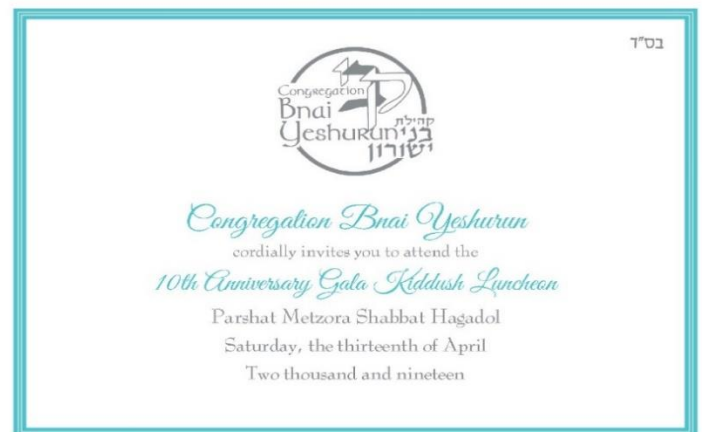

## “Majesty of Kabbalat Shabbat” This Sunday Morning

Rabbi Arie Folger, Chief Rabbi of Vienna, will discuss *The Majesty of Kabbalat Shabbat* this Sunday morning at 9:30 am in a special *shiur* arranged by the CBY Beis Medrash Program.



Chief Rabbi of Vienna since 2016, Rabbi Folger had served as rabbi of the Israelitische Gemeinde Basel in Switzerland since the beginning of 2003 and in various other congregations, including Munich

and Frankfurt. Rabbi Folger's *semicha* is from the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary. He also holds an MBA at New York University.

Having lived in several countries, Rabbi Folger is fluent in six languages (Dutch, English, French, German, Hebrew and Yiddish) and has lectured in all of them. He played a major role in the drafting and editing on the 2017 document *Between Judaism and Rome; Reflections on 50 Years of Nostra Aetate*. (*Nostra Aetate* was the Vatican document, written in 1965, that re-examined Christianity's views of Judaism and other religions.)
