CBY Rabbinic Survey Nears Completion

Would you have guessed that 90% of CBY members consider it likely or highly likely that they will still live in Teaneck 5-10 years from now? Or that the number one reason for attending CBY is not proximity to their residence, but rather the Rabbi / Rabbinic staff? How about two of the top goals for CBY over the next 2-5 years being "to attract more young members, reduce average age" and "to foster a warmer, friendlier atmosphere"?

These and many other fascinating insights into our *kehilla* are emerging from the CBY Rabbinic Survey, which is nearing completion, and will close at 11:59 pm on Sunday, August 25. More than 500 members have responded, representing more than half of our membership (counting both spouses as individual members). This is an excellent response rate, but we hope that anyone who has not yet responded will do so this weekend. We want everyone's opinions to be heard and considered.



The survey is the second of several steps in the rabbinic search process. The first was a series of focus groups, conducted in May and June. These focus groups were attended by over 100 members and were used to highlight issues that our congregants feel are important, either to the search process or to the future of our shul. The focus group results were compiled by YU's Center for the Jewish Future, presented to the Rabbinic Transition Committee, and used to assist in the development of survey questions.

The objectives of the survey are twofold. First, we are attempting to collect views regarding a congregational vision, and identify concerns that may be important to our future as a thriving Orthodox synagogue. The second objective, of course, is to provide guidance to the Rabbinic Search Committee as to what characteristics, background and beliefs are most important to us for our future rabbi.

Evelyn will post a message to TeaneckShuls every 2 weeks, containing only the Hebrew name of all the people requiring tehillim. There will be no mention of the name of the person who submitted the request. All information, other than the Hebrew name, sent to Evelyn, will be kept in strict confidence. Every 3 months, Evelyn will contact the person who submitted the info asking if there is still a need for tehillim to be said, so she can keep the list current & timely. Anyone not responding to Evelyn's email will be removed from the tehillim list at that time. This list is meant for long term illness-type situations. Those requiring tehillim in the event of an immediate surgery, sudden accident, emergency type nature may, of course, post directly to TeaneckShuls on their own. We pray that this tehillim list will remain short & people will have no use for it.
