## Bnai Yeshurun Hosts Special OU Daf Yomi Program

This Shabbat, Bnai Yeshurun will host two special lectures that are presented as part of the OU's *Daf Yomi* Initiative. At 7:30 am, Rabbi Moshe Elefant, whose daily online *Daf Yomi shiur* is one of the most popular in the world, will teach the *daf* in our *Beis Medrash*, before the *Nusach Sefard Minyan*. He will also teach the *Minchas Chinuch shiur* following *davening*. At 5:40 pm, following *Mincha*, well-known Jewish history scholar Dr. Henry Abramson, will speak on *Murder in the Print Shop? The Bizarre Story behind the Canonization of the Vilna Shas*.

The lectures are part of a community-wide *בראשית* program organized by the Orthodox Union. For lectures at other local shuls please see the Community Announcements.

Rabbi Moshe Elefant is Chief Operating Officer of OU Kosher and the *maggid shiur* of the Orthodox Union's *Daf Yomi* webcast (with 1,800 learners a day around the globe). For listeners to the popular Talkline With Zev Brenner radio program, Rabbi Elefant's name has additionally become strongly identified with the Passover holiday, as he joins the host on air the for the weeks leading up to the holiday to help people with their *kashrut* questions

Dr. Henry Abramson is Dean of the Lander College of Arts and Sciences in Flatbush. Dr. Abramson received his doctorate in history from the University of Toronto, the first PhD in Ukrainian-Jewish history presented since the Chair of Ukrainian Studies was established there. He has held appointments at a number of prestigious institutions including Oxford University, Cornell University, Harvard University and Hebrew University.

The *Daf Yomi* concept dates back to 1923, when Rabbi Yehuda Meir Shapiro, a revered European scholar, encouraged Jews to take on the practice of studying one *daf*, consisting of two sides of a page of the Babylonian Talmud, per day.

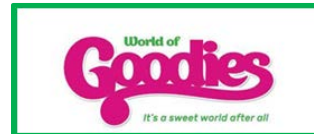

In 1930, at the end of that first seven-and-a-half-year learning cycle, having completed the entire 2,711 pages of the Talmud, European Jewry celebrated the momentous accomplishment with a *Siyum HaShas* (literally, "the completion of the Talmud"). The celebration of the 13th *Siyum HaShas*, which concludes Shabbat, the 7th of Tevet 5780 (January 4, 2020), will be held by various organizations in January 2020, with the main event by Agudath Israel of America at MetLife Stadium on January 1. As we approach the beginning of a new cycle, this would be an opportune time, without making a long-term commitment, for members to learn the *daf* every day for a few years and see how they like it. If you need additional motivation, why not listen to one of our guest lecturers this Shabbat?
