U.S. Envoy Carr Analyzes Growing Global Anti-Semitism

This past Tuesday evening, Elan Carr, Special U.S. Envoy to Monitor and Combat Anti-Semitism, visited Bnai Yeshurun to present his views and approach to the "new anti-Semitism." Appointed in February by Secretary of State Mike Pompeo, Carr is responsible for U.S. policies and projects aimed at countering anti-Semitism throughout the world.

Descended from a distinguished and scholarly Jewish family, Carr began his presentation with a brief but poignant recounting of how his grandfather was falsely accused in an Iraqi anti-Semitic show trial in 1948. Carr's mother and uncle had to flee the country and eventually went to Israel and the United States. Years later, when serving as a lieutenant in the U.S. army, Carr was sent to participate in the liberation of Iraq and he described how he led U.S. soldiers in lighting a Chanukah menorah in Saddam Hussein's presidential palace.



Carr urged his audience to recognize that "we're in a war" against the "metastatic cancer" of anti-Semitism. He explained that this threat comes from three primary sources: the ethnic supremacy of the right, Israel hating on the left and militant Islamists. He bemoaned the fact that textbooks in countries that are allies of the United States continue to teach anti-Semitism to its children.

American college students are often bombarded with anti-Israel propaganda from both faculty members and fellow students, he explained. This is one of the reasons that many younger Americans, including Jews and Christian evangelicals, are less supportive of Israel than were their parents. Carr recommended that students who experience any anti-semitism should speak up and or notify authorities.

Carr assured attendees that President Trump, Secretary of State Pompeo and other key cabinet members are united in battling anti-Semitism on the college campus and wherever it appears and are fully supportive of the State of Israel. The BDS movement is, at its core, anti-Semitic, he said. Economic boycott can be a legitimate way to express an opinion and influence world events, he said, but BDS is anti-Semitic and its goal is the elimination of the Jewish state.

A lengthy Q&A session followed. One audience member said that the Catholic Church needed to apologize for giving rise to so much anti-Semitism. Carr responded that the Vatican has "pretty much" apologized and that the current rise in anti-Semitism is not the historic religious anti-Semitism. When another audience member raised the issue that Democrats were not acting forcefully against anti-Semitism, Carr quickly cited a long list of Democrats, Jews and non-Jews, who were vocally combatting anti-Semitism and effectively supporting Israel, singling out our own House representative, Josh Gottheimer, for special mention. He added that we should not take a divisive approach when fighting anti-Semitism or supporting Israel. Most legislators, both Republican and Democratic, are with us on these critical issues.

Rabbi Dr. Shmidman to Address The Reinstitution of Korbanot

Three times each day we pray for the rebuilding of the *Beit HaMikdash* and the reinstatement of the bringing of *korbanot*, animal sacrifices. To some, this practice may seem problematic or outdated. On Shabbat afternoon, August 3rd, following *mincha bizman*, noted Jewish scholar Rabbi Dr. Michael Shmidman will speak on *What did the Rambam Really Think About the Reinstitution of Korbanot?: Maimonides and Nachmanides on the Utilization of Historical Causation in Ta'amei Ha-Mitzvot*.



Rabbi Shmidman is Dean and Victor J. Selmanowitz Professor of Jewish History at Touro Graduate School of Jewish Studies and Editor of Touro University Press. Born in Brooklyn, the son of a prominent rabbi and Talmudic scholar, Rabbi Shmidman always assumed he would pursue a career in the rabbinate. However, along the way he developed a passionate interest in academic Jewish studies. After graduating from Yeshiva College, he studied Jewish philosophy at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem where he received his M.A. and medieval Jewish history at Harvard University. He received his Ph.D. from Harvard and has published and lectured extensively in the areas of medieval Jewish history and Maimonidean studies.

Rabbi Shmidman served as Orthodox rabbi of Harvard Hillel from 1974 to 1976, and as rabbi of Congregation Keter Torah in Teaneck from 1998 to 2003. He is a member of the Association for Jewish Studies, the Medieval Academy of America, and the Rabbinical Council of America. He also served as Editor of TRADITION: A Journal of Orthodox Jewish Thought.
